Over the next few months, Fashion functionality will be removed from Walmart's legacy tools as **Supplier One** becomes your day-to-day item management tool. Category Advisors and Suppliers who also sell in Canada should continue using Item 360.

Note: If you use a data pool provider to publish synced item info with GDSN (which is recommended but not required), make sure the data is pushed to Walmart before starting your Fashion item setup or maintenance in Item 360 or Supplier One.
