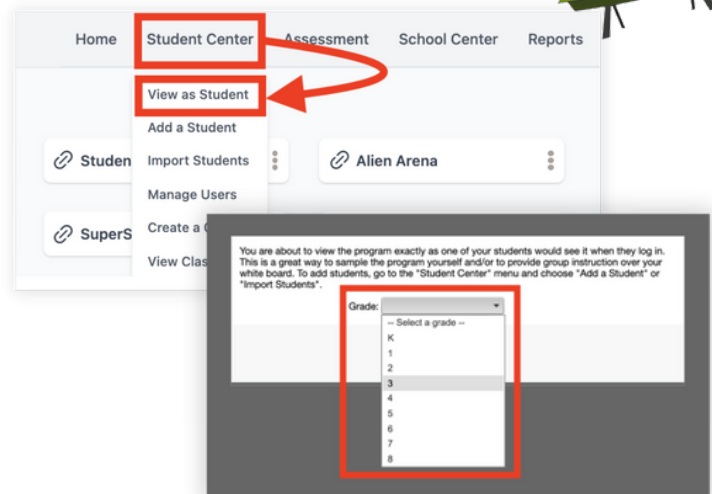
Getting Started with K-1 Students

- Login as a teacher and under the “Student Center” select “View as Student.”
- Show your class where they find practice in math and reading in the Study Plan.

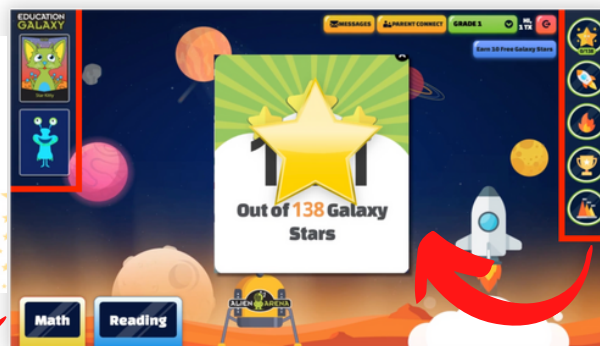


- 2 Discuss with your class and get them excited about the goals of earning Galaxy Stars and ranking up with Alien Ranking levels as they learn and work hard. Look [here](#) for some examples.

How to Earn Galaxy Stars

Work on MY STUDY PLAN topics to earn Galaxy Stars.
Earn up to 3 stars per topic.
Must complete full 10 question session to earn stars.

- 3 Continue modeling how to navigate to the Study Plan for math or reading for your class in a whole group setting.

- Complete a session on a standard you are teaching to review as guided practice, close a lesson, or as a station.



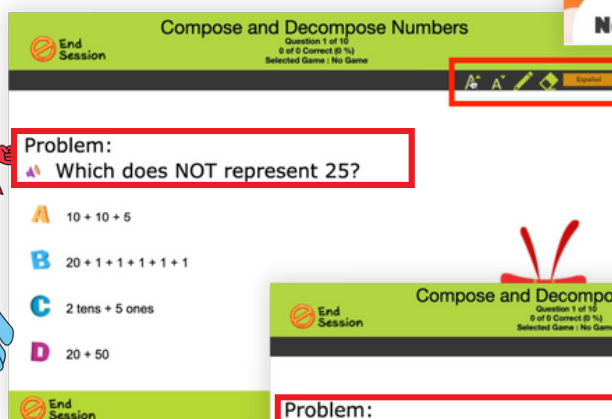
4 Once students are familiar with the platform, start having them login to their individual accounts. This may occur around October or November.

5 Once students are logged into their individual accounts, click on the math or reading labels and find the picture of the standard you are currently working on. You can model for your class where to go by being logged in as a teacher and under the “Student Center” select “View as Student.”

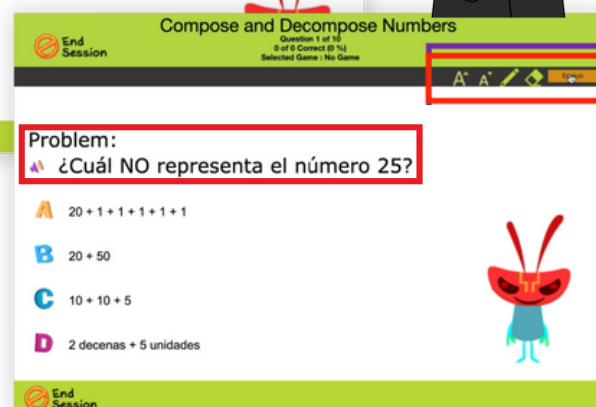
- You can also show your students how to click on the main-screen rocket to find assigned work.



- Model with your class where to click the microphone icon to hear text read-aloud to them



- If you have language learners, have them practice using the toggle feature from English to Spanish if that is enabled as a language support



6 Continue having your class sign in to their own student accounts and practicing their standards or assignments.

- Our program is supplemental and all of their progress and work is always saved if they don't complete their assignment or 10 questions during their practice in math or reading in their Study Plan.
- For 1st-grade students that are struggling, have them click on the button that says Grade 1 in the upper right-hand corner of the student dashboard and click down 1 level, and this will move them to Kindergarten standards.
