

RSpace WCAG Accessibility Self-Assessment

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A self-assessment of RSpace's compliance with the [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\) 2.2](#) was undertaken by front-end RSpace engineer Robert Lamacraft on 26th June 2025, on RSpace version v1.111.1 running on demos.researchspace.com.

The following table outlines RSpace's compliance with each criterion, with regards to the three major areas of the product: the Workspace & Document Editor, the Gallery, and Inventory. The criteria are categorised into three levels of conformance: **A (lowest)**, **AA**, and **AAA (highest)**. In situations where we cannot be certain that RSpace supports the criteria in all instances, we have deferred to evaluating the criteria as "Partially supports" as to not over-evaluate. We provide explanation of values marked with an asterisk (*) in the Notes section.

Note that this is not an official accessibility report, thus it is not legally binding. We also acknowledge that this self-assessment is not equivalent to a professional audit, which needs to be performed by persons with accessibility needs.

RSpace is currently undergoing a major refactor of its interface, thus the valuation presented in this list will improve rapidly, and while we aim to review our accessibility support periodically, this document is likely to fall behind on what we actually offer at any point in time. Notes

1.3.3 Sensory Characteristics

- Inventory: visual containers are not accessible

1.4.5 Images of Text, 1.4.9 Images of Text (No Exception)

- Text in the deployment-customisable header image is not encoded in alt text

1.4.6 Contrast (Enhanced)

- Gallery, Inventory: supported when high-contrast mode is enabled

1.4.13 Content on Hover or Focus

- Workspace & Document Editor, Gallery: there is no content on hover
- Inventory: the informational popups can be closed with the escape key

2.1.2 No Keyboard Trap

- Workspace & Document Editor: difficult to fully verify

2.1.3 Keyboard (No Exception)

- Workspace & Document Editor: some content is not reachable from keyboard controls alone
- Gallery: tree view does not work with keyboard controls, possibly other elements
- Inventory: help popup cannot be closed with keyboard controls, possibly other elements

2.2.1 Timing Adjustable

- Gallery: there are no time limits
- Inventory: when the edit lock expires, the user is given enough time to take action

2.2.2 Pause, Stop, Hide

- No content that moves for more than five seconds and presented in parallel with other content

2.2.3 No Timing

- Workspace & Document Editor: it is possible that there are error messages that auto-dismiss
- Gallery, Inventory: success toasts automatically dismiss, but they are not essential for usage

2.2.4 Interruptions

- There is no mechanism to disable interruptions, although almost all changes to content must be initiated by the user

2.4.4 Link Purpose (In Context)

- Workspace & Document Editor: links in the sidebar tree are one example where the purpose is not descriptive

2.4.5 Multiple Ways

- Items can be found through search or through navigating the tree structure, but there is no sitemap or equivalent

- Gallery: there is no Gallery-wide search

2.4.8 Location

- Workspace & Document Editor: there is often a breadcrumb displayed, but not from within the Document Editor, and it may not be obvious to open the navigation tree in the sidebar
- Gallery: a breadcrumb trail is always available, unless a dialog is open
- Inventory: there is always either:
 - A. a breadcrumb trail and sidebar
 - B. a header and sidebar (in the case of import)
 - C. a back button (single column view) to return to (A.)

2.4.9 Link Purpose (Link Only)

- Difficult to verify every link; verification would also not include user-generated content

2.5.7 Dragging Movements

- Gallery: Drag-and-drop actions can always be performed with the move dialog
- Inventory: visual containers have no alternative to dragging

2.5.8 Target Size (Minimum)

- Workspace & Document Editor: info buttons are too small

3.1.2 Language of Parts

- Everything is always in English

3.2.1 On Focus

- We do not navigate the user when an element is focused

3.2.3 Consistent Navigation

- Workspace & Document Editor: app bar does not change
- Gallery, Inventory: sidebar and app bar do not change

3.2.4 Consistent Identification

- Gallery: only within the Gallery, not against the rest of the product
- Inventory: only within Inventory, not against the rest of the product

3.2.5 Change on Request

- We don't navigate the user without their action.

3.3.4 Error Prevention (Legal, Financial, Data), 3.3.6 Error Prevention (All)

- Gallery: there is no mechanism for restoring deleted files nor is there a confirmation step
- Inventory: there is no mechanism to undo, modify, or review note submissions on subsamples

3.3.5 Help

- Inventory: some parts of the UI have contextual links to documentation

3.3.8 Accessible Authentication (Minimum), 3.3.9 Accessible Authentication (Enhanced)

- Login page allowing pasting and password managers satisfies

4.1.1 Parsing

- Workspace & Document Editor: difficult to fully verify
