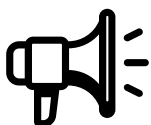


1 DAY STUDENT SUPPORT & PREVENTION WORKSHOP

Cyber Safety & Cyberbullying Education:

- Workshops for students from 1st to 12th grades
- Workshops are voluntary and not a suspension
- The hours of instruction vary depending of the grade of the student:
 - 1st to 3rd: 2 hours
 - 4th and 5th: 3 hours
 - 6th to 12th: 5 hours
- Schools may also request whole classroom workshops
