

Using the Peppol Network for Domestic E-Invoicing in Italy

Overview

The Peppol (Pan-European Public Procurement On-Line) network enables standardized electronic document exchange between businesses. For Italian domestic e-invoicing, both sender and receiver communicate through access points like HubBroker, which acts as the service provider connecting participants to the Peppol network.

Key Components

Participants

- **Sender**: The business issuing the e-invoice
- **Receiver:** The business receiving the e-invoice
- **Service Provider (HubBroker)**: The certified Peppol access point facilitating the exchange

Identification

Each participant needs a Peppol ID (also called Participant ID), which in Italy typically uses:

- VAT number (Partita IVA) format: 9907:ITxxxxxxxxxxx (11 digits)
- Codice Fiscale format: 0210:ITxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx (for individuals/professionals)
- Codice Destinatario format: 0201:ITxxxxxxx (7-character SDI code)
- GLN (Global Location Number) format: 0088:80xxxxxxxxxx

Italian SDI (Sistema di Interscambio) System

Italy has a unique mandatory e-invoicing system that all domestic invoices must pass through:

SDI Overview

- Mandatory since 2019: All B2B, B2C, and B2G domestic invoices must be transmitted via SDI
- **Central hub:** SDI is operated by Italian Revenue Agency (Agenzia delle Entrate)
- Validation and routing: SDI validates invoices and routes them to recipients
- **Tax compliance:** Primary purpose is VAT monitoring and tax fraud prevention
- FatturaPA format: Specific XML format required for SDI submission



How SDI Works

- Sender creates invoice in FatturaPA XML format
- Invoice is sent to SDI (directly or via intermediary)
- SDI validates the invoice format and content
- 4. SDI assigns unique invoice identifier
- 5. SDI routes invoice to recipient based on their registered delivery channel
- 6. SDI provides delivery receipt to sender
- 7. SDI stores invoice data for tax authority access

Outbound E-Invoicing Process (Sending)

1. Registration with HubBroker

- The sender registers as a Peppol participant through HubBroker
- Sender also registers their delivery preferences with SDI (if not already done)
- HubBroker registers the sender in the Peppol SMP (Service Metadata Publisher) directory

2. Invoice Creation

- Sender creates invoice in their ERP/accounting system
- Invoice is converted to FatturaPA XML format for SDI compliance

3. Dual Transmission via HubBroker

A. For Italian domestic invoices:

- HubBroker submits the invoice to SDI system (mandatory)
- HubBroker receives SDI acknowledgment and delivery status
- Optionally, HubBroker can also send via Peppol for enhanced business workflow

B. For cross-border invoices:

- HubBroker converts to Peppol BIS Billing 3.0 format (UBL or CII XML)
- HubBroker sends through Peppol network to international trading partners

4. Delivery Confirmation

- HubBroker provides SDI delivery status back to the sender
- Sender receives confirmation of SDI acceptance and delivery to receiver
- For Peppol cross-border: confirmation that invoice reached receiver's access point



Inbound E-Invoicing Process (Receiving)

Registration with HubBroker

- The receiver registers their Peppol ID with HubBroker
- Receiver registers their Codice Destinatario with SDI, pointing to HubBroker's channel
- HubBroker publishes the receiver's endpoint information in the Peppol SMP directory

Invoice Reception from SDI

- When a sender transmits an invoice via SDI to the receiver's Codice Destinatario
- SDI validates and routes the invoice to HubBroker's accredited channel
- HubBroker receives the FatturaPA XML from SDI

Invoice Reception from Peppol (Cross-border)

- International senders use Peppol network
- HubBroker receives Peppol BIS format invoice
- HubBroker converts to FatturaPA and submits to SDI (if required for Italian tax compliance)

Processing via HubBroker

- HubBroker receives and validates the incoming e-invoice
- HubBroker can transform the invoice format if needed (e.g., from FatturaPA XML to receiver's preferred format)
- HubBroker sends delivery receipt to SDI (mandatory acknowledgment)
- HubBroker notifies the receiver of the new invoice

Delivery to Receiver

Invoice is delivered to the receiver through their preferred method:

- Direct integration with ERP/accounting system (API)
- Web portal access through HubBroker's platform
- Email notification with download link
- File transfer (SFTP, AS2, etc.)

Italian-Specific Requirements

For domestic Italian e-invoicing, ensure:

- FatturaPA format: Mandatory XML format for all domestic invoices
- SDI transmission: All Italian domestic B2B/B2C invoices must pass through SDI





- Codice Destinatario: 7-character code identifying receiver's delivery channel
- PEC alternative: Certified email (PEC) can be used if Codice Destinatario not provided
- Partita IVA: Italian VAT number must be correctly formatted
- **Digital signature**: Optional but recommended XML digital signature (XAdES)
- Conservazione sostitutiva: Legal requirement for digital preservation (10 years)
- **Language:** Invoice content typically in Italian for domestic transactions
- **Currency**: EUR (Euro) is the standard currency for Italian invoicing

Benefits of Using HubBroker as Service Provider

- **SDI accreditation**: HubBroker is an accredited SDI channel partner
- **Dual compliance**: HubBroker handles both mandatory SDI submission and optional Peppol exchange
- Format handling: Automatic conversion between FatturaPA and Peppol BIS formats
- International reach: Single connection for both Italian domestic (via SDI) and cross-border (via Peppol) invoicing
- Compliance: Ensures invoices meet both SDI/FatturaPA and Peppol requirements

Implementation Steps

- 1. Choose identifiers:

 - Codice Destinatario (7-character SDI code provided by HubBroker)
- Sign agreement with HubBroker as your Peppol access point provider and SDI channel partner
- SDI registration:
 - Register Codice Destinatario with Italian Revenue Agency
 - Point it to HubBroker's accredited channel
- Configure integration between your systems and HubBroker
- 5. Test transactions in both SDI test environment and HubBroker's test environment
- 6. Go live and start exchanging e-invoices domestically (via SDI) and internationally (via Peppol)







Italian E-Invoicing Landscape

Italy has one of Europe's most comprehensive mandatory e-invoicing systems:

Current Status

- Mandatory since January 2019: All B2B and B2C domestic invoices
- **SDI central hub**: All domestic invoices must pass through SDI
- **Tax compliance focus:** Primary objective is VAT fraud prevention
- High compliance: Near 100% adoption rate for Italian businesses
- FatturaPA standard: Specific Italian XML format (based on UBL but with Italian customizations)
- Public and private: Mandate covers both B2G and B2B/B2C transactions

Historical Context

- 2014-2018: FatturaPA mandatory for public sector (B2G)
- January 2019: Extended to all B2B and B2C transactions
- **Exemptions**: Very limited (mainly cross-border transactions and specific sectors)

Understanding the Dual System

SDI Sistema di Interscambio (Mandatory for Domestic)

- Purpose: Tax compliance, VAT monitoring, and invoice routing
- Recipient: Italian Revenue Agency (Agenzia delle Entrate) processes all invoices
- Scope: All Italian domestic B2B, B2C, and B2G invoices
- Format: FatturaPA XML format
- **Requirement**: Mandatory by law
- **Geography**: Italian domestic transactions only

Peppol Network (For Cross-Border and Enhanced Workflow)

- Purpose: International invoice exchange and enhanced business document workflow
- **Recipient:** International trading partners outside Italy
- **Scope**: Cross-border transactions with EU and global partners
- Format: Peppol BIS Billing 3.0 (UBL/CII)
- **Requirement:** Optional but recommended for international trade
- **Geography:** International transactions

HubBroker's Integrated Role

HubBroker manages both aspects:

Domestic Italian invoices: Submission to SDI in FatturaPA format (mandatory)





- Cross-border invoices: Transmission via Peppol in international formats
- Format conversion: Between FatturaPA and Peppol BIS formats
- **Unified interface**: Single integration point for all invoicing needs
- Compliance assurance: Both SDI and Peppol requirements met

FatturaPA Format Overview

Key Characteristics

- XML-based: Structured XML format
- Italian customization: Based on UBL but adapted for Italian requirements
- Mandatory fields: Specific Italian tax and business information required
- **Version control**: Currently FatturaPA v1.2.2 or later
- XSD validation: Must validate against official Italian schema

Required Elements

- Partita IVA (VAT numbers) for both parties
- Codice Destinatario or PEC address
- Payment terms and methods
- Tax breakdown by rate
- Document type codes (Italian specific)
- Optional: Ritenuta (withholding tax), Bollo (stamp duty), Cassa previdenziale

Public Sector (B2G) Considerations

For invoicing Italian public entities:

- PA (Pubblica Amministrazione): Public administration entities
- IPA code: Unique identifier for each public entity (used as Codice Destinatario)
- Mandatory since 2014: E-invoicing to Italian public sector
- Same process: Uses SDI system like B2B invoices
- **Enhanced requirements**: May require additional fields or specifications
- **HubBroker support**: Handles public sector-specific requirements

Cross-Border Invoicing

Outbound (Italian to International)

- **SDI exemption**: Cross-border invoices do NOT go through SDI
- **Peppol advantage**: Use Peppol network for seamless international exchange
- Format: Peppol BIS Billing 3.0 (international standard)
- **Compliance**: EU e-invoicing directive EN 16931 compliant







Inbound (International to Italian)

- **Option 1**: Foreign sender uses Peppol → HubBroker receives and optionally processes
- Option 2: Foreign sender submits directly to SDI (if registered)
- **VAT rules**: Reverse charge and intra-community rules apply
- **Documentation:** Additional customs/tax documentation may be required

Technical Considerations

SDI Technical Requirements

- Accreditation: Service providers must be accredited by Agenzia delle Entrate
- **Protocols**: FTP, web service, or PEC for SDI transmission
- Message types: Various SDI message types for notifications and receipts
- **Error handling**: Specific error codes from SDI requiring corrective action
- **Delivery receipts:** Multiple receipt types (acceptance, delivery, rejection)

Integration Architecture

- Single API: HubBroker provides unified API for both SDI and Peppol
- Automatic routing: HubBroker determines whether invoice goes via SDI or Peppol
- Format detection: Automatic conversion based on destination
- Status tracking: Real-time visibility of both SDI and Peppol transactions

Conservazione Sostitutiva (Digital Preservation)

Italian law requires:

- **10-year retention**: E-invoices must be preserved for 10 years
- **Legal validity**: Preserved documents must maintain legal value
- **Technical requirements**: Specific standards for digital preservation
- **Timestamp and signature:** Documents must be timestamped and may require qualified signatures
- HubBroker support: Can facilitate or integrate with conservation services

Common Challenges and Solutions

- **Challenge:** Format Complexity
- **Solution:** HubBroker handles all FatturaPA format requirements automatically
- **Challenge:** SDI Rejections
- Solution: HubBroker provides clear error messages and resubmission capabilities







- **Challenge**: International Trade
- **Solution**: Seamless switching between SDI (domestic) and Peppol (international)
- **Challenge:** Multiple Systems
- **Solution**: Single integration with HubBroker covers all scenarios
- **Challenge:** Compliance Updates
- **Solution:** HubBroker maintains compliance with SDI updates and changes

Preparing for Italian E-Invoicing

To successfully implement Italian e-invoicing:

- Understand SDI mandate: All domestic invoices must go through SDI
- Obtain Codice Destinatario: Register with HubBroker for SDI channel
- System capability: Ensure ERP can generate required invoice data
- **HubBroker integration**: Single integration for both SDI and Peppol
- FatturaPA compliance: Verify all mandatory fields are captured
- **Testing:** Thorough testing in SDI test environment
- **Staff training**: Ensure team understands Italian e-invoicing requirements
- Conservation plan: Establish digital preservation process
- **International strategy:** Leverage Peppol for cross-border transactions
