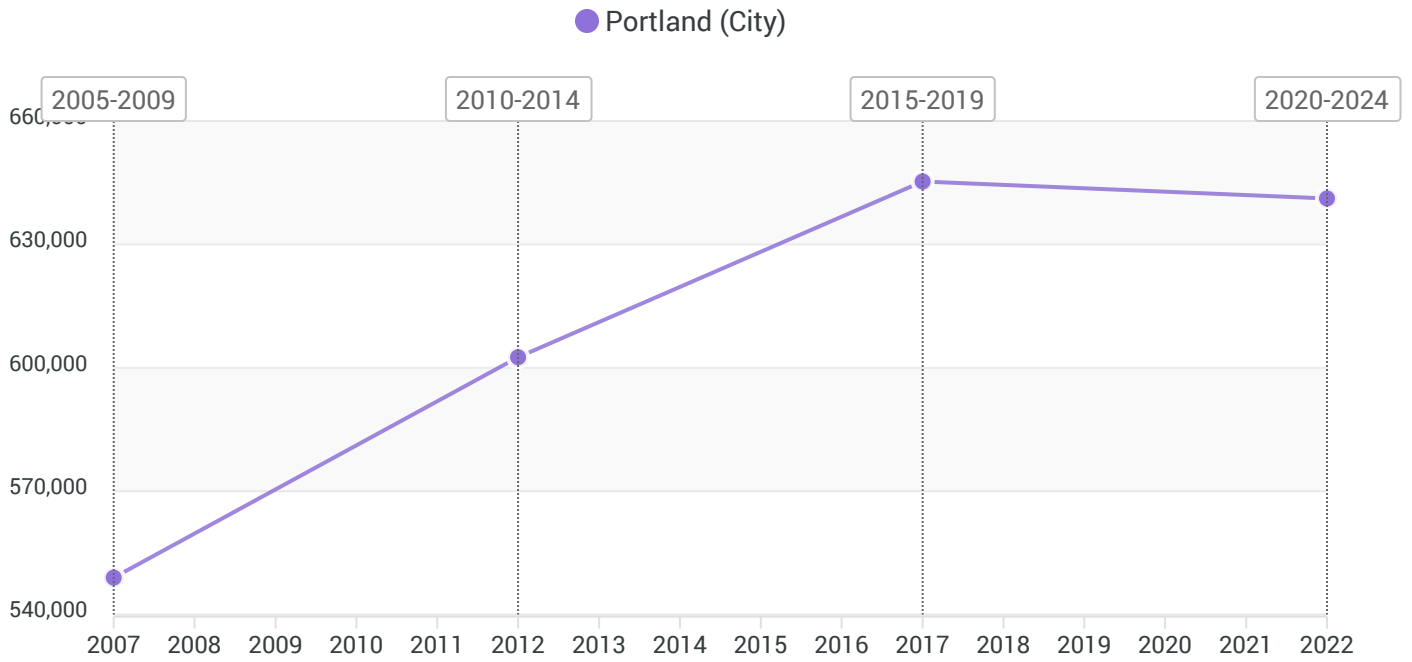

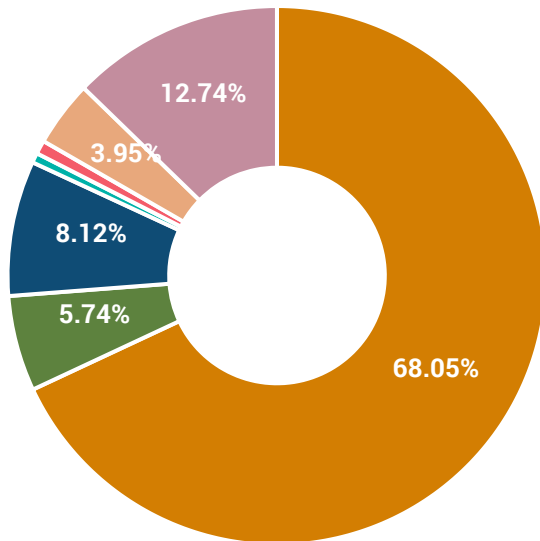

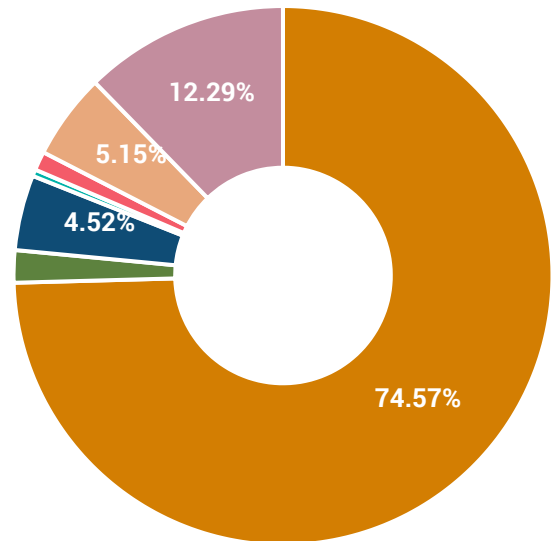

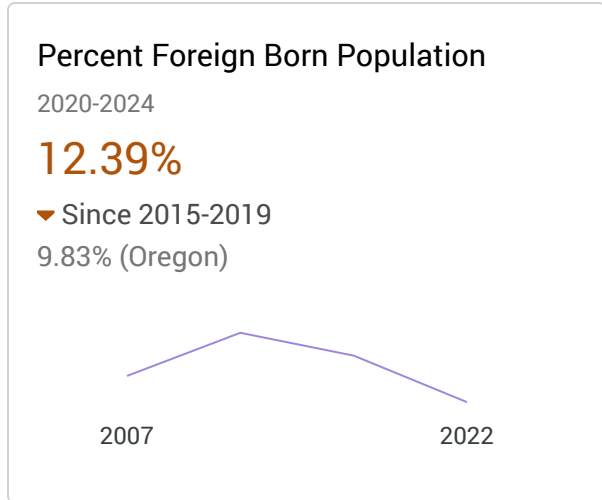

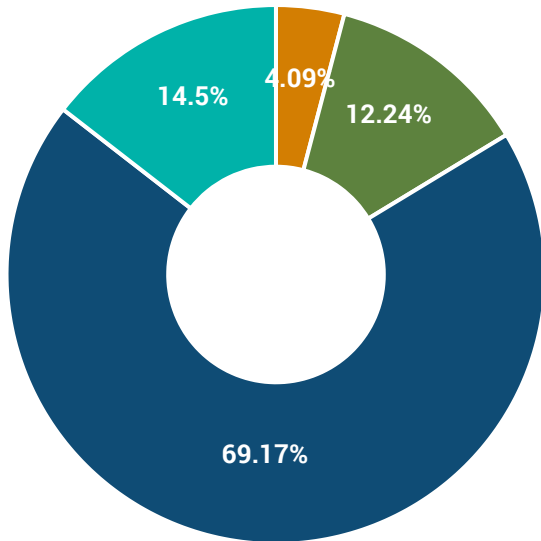

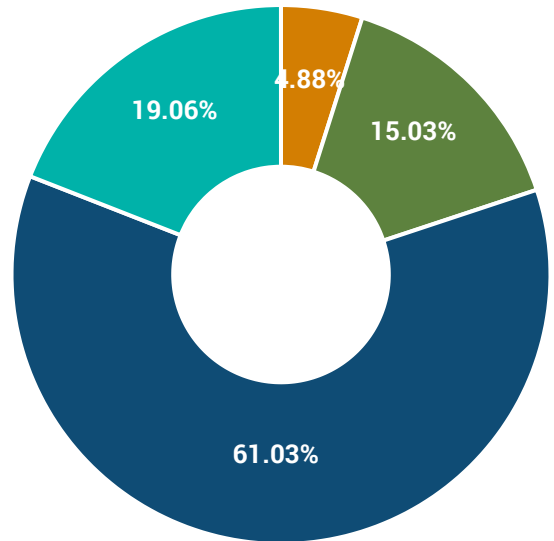
Age Distribution

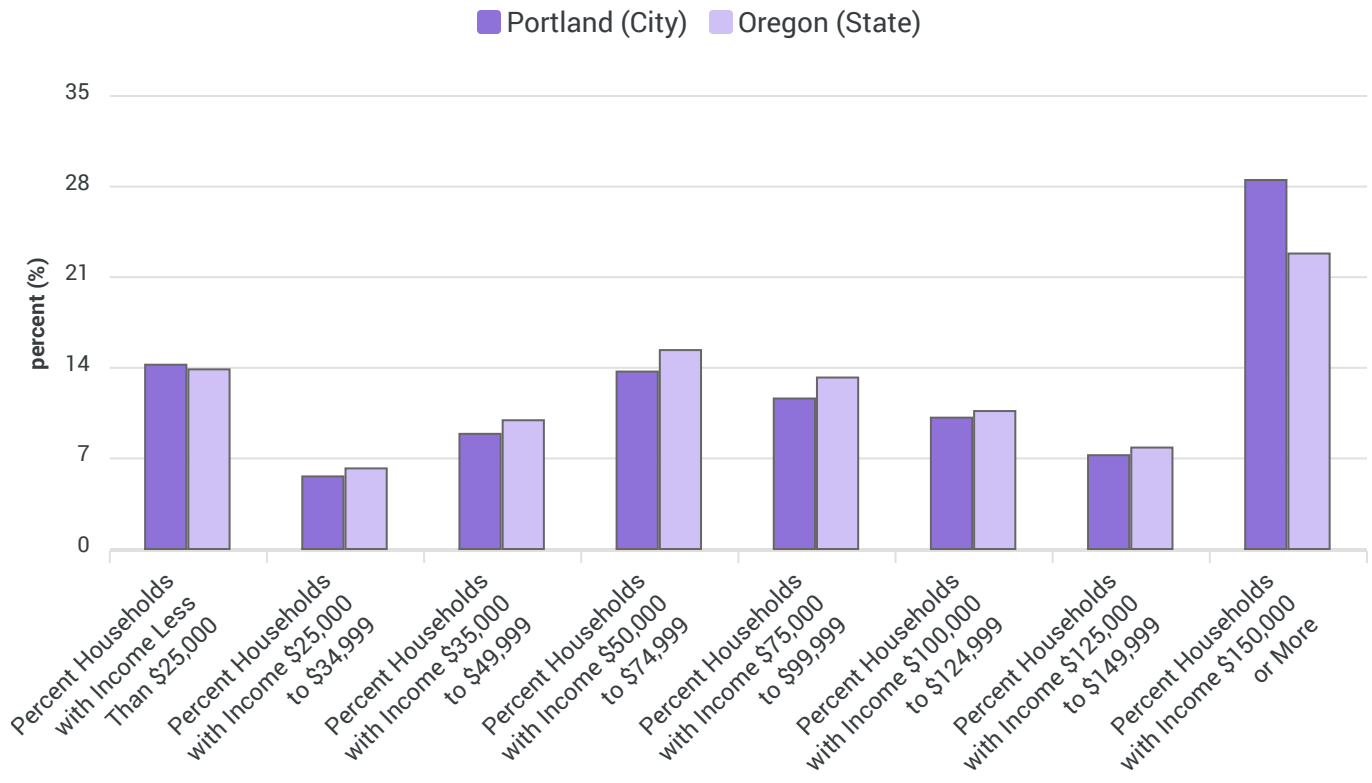


- Percent Population Ages 0-4

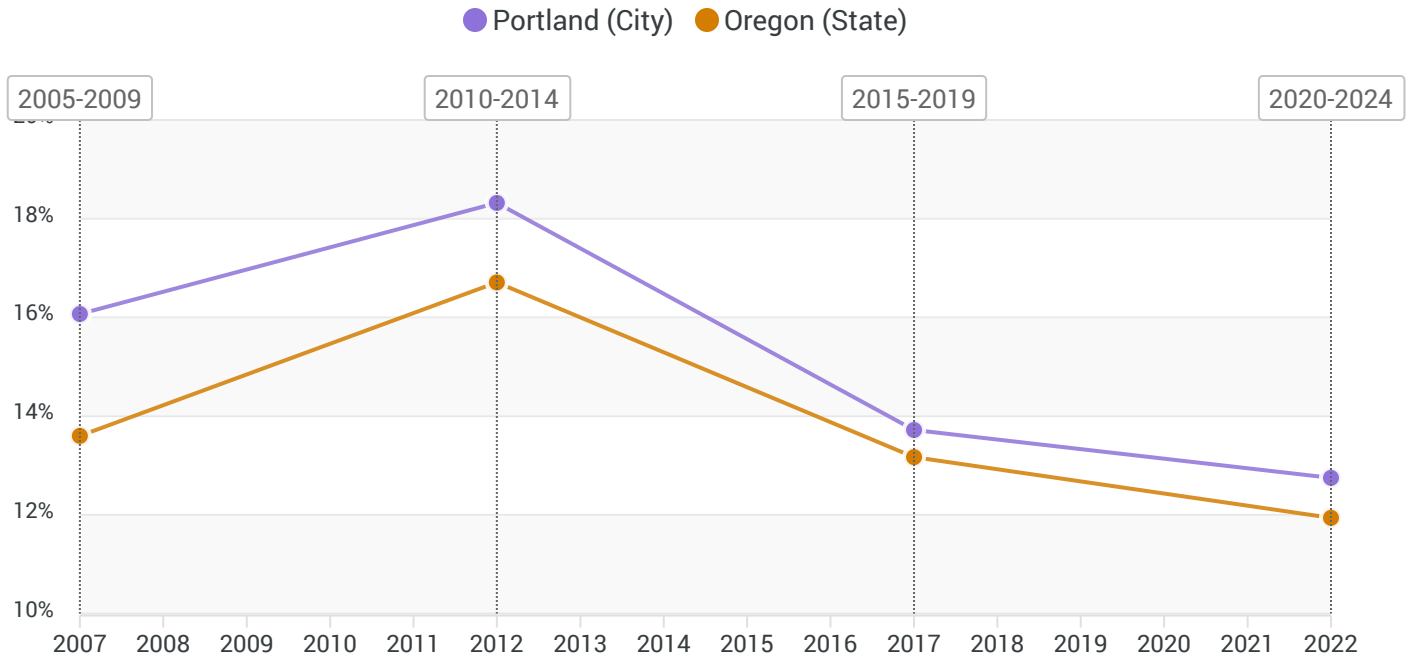
Income and Poverty

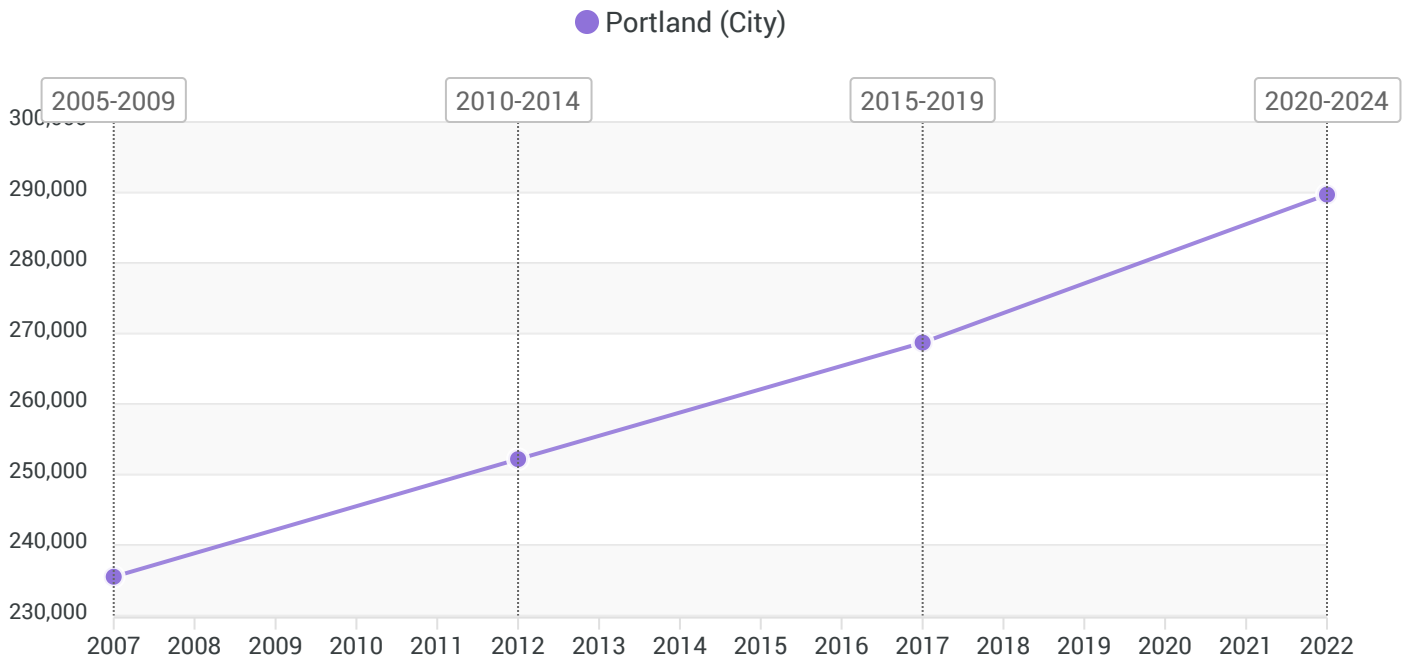

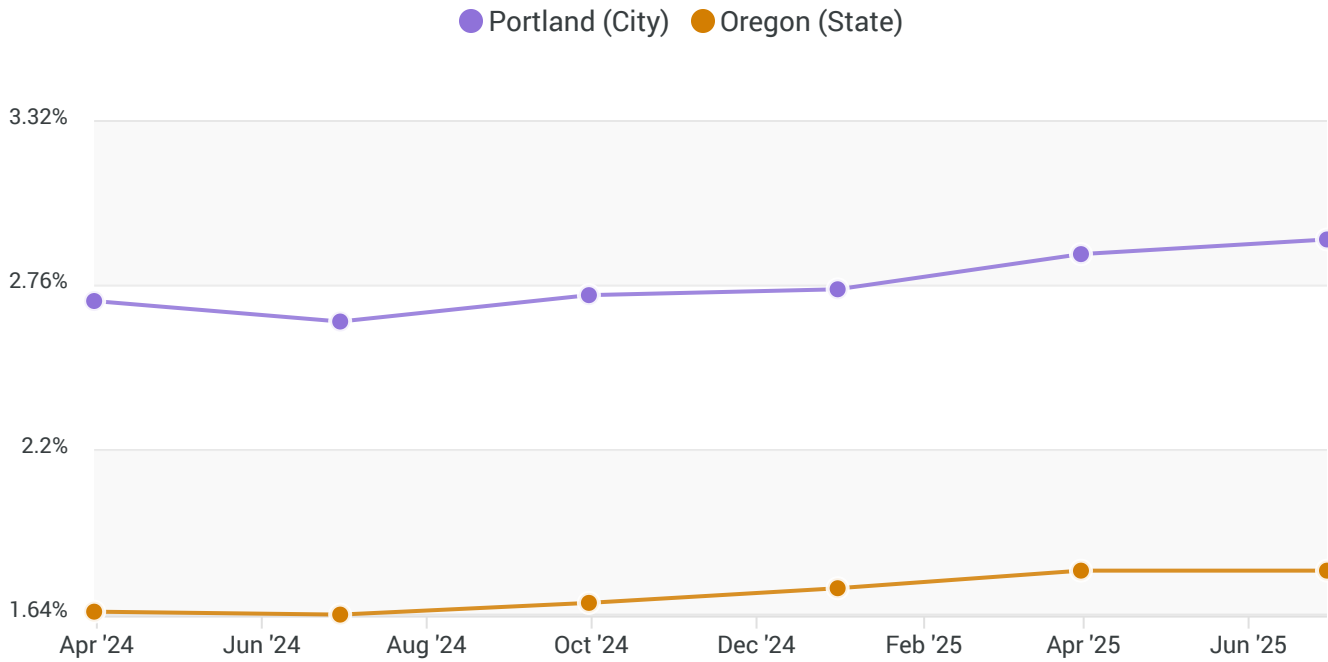

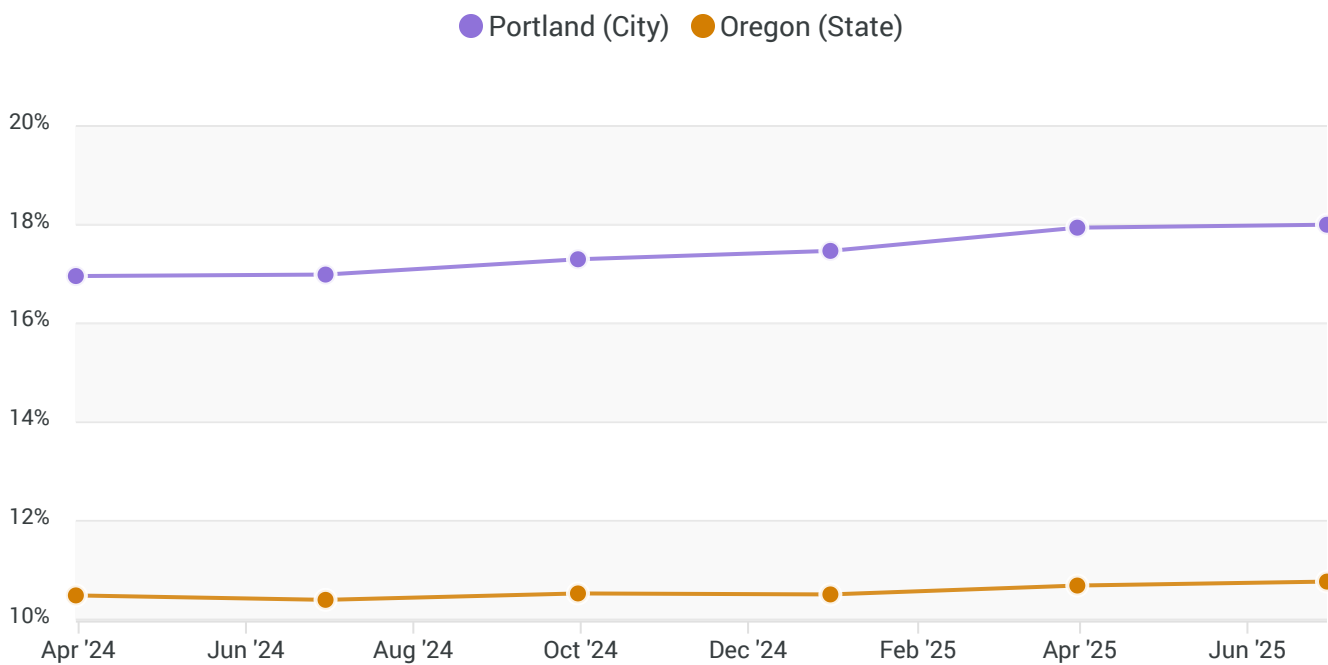
Vacancy

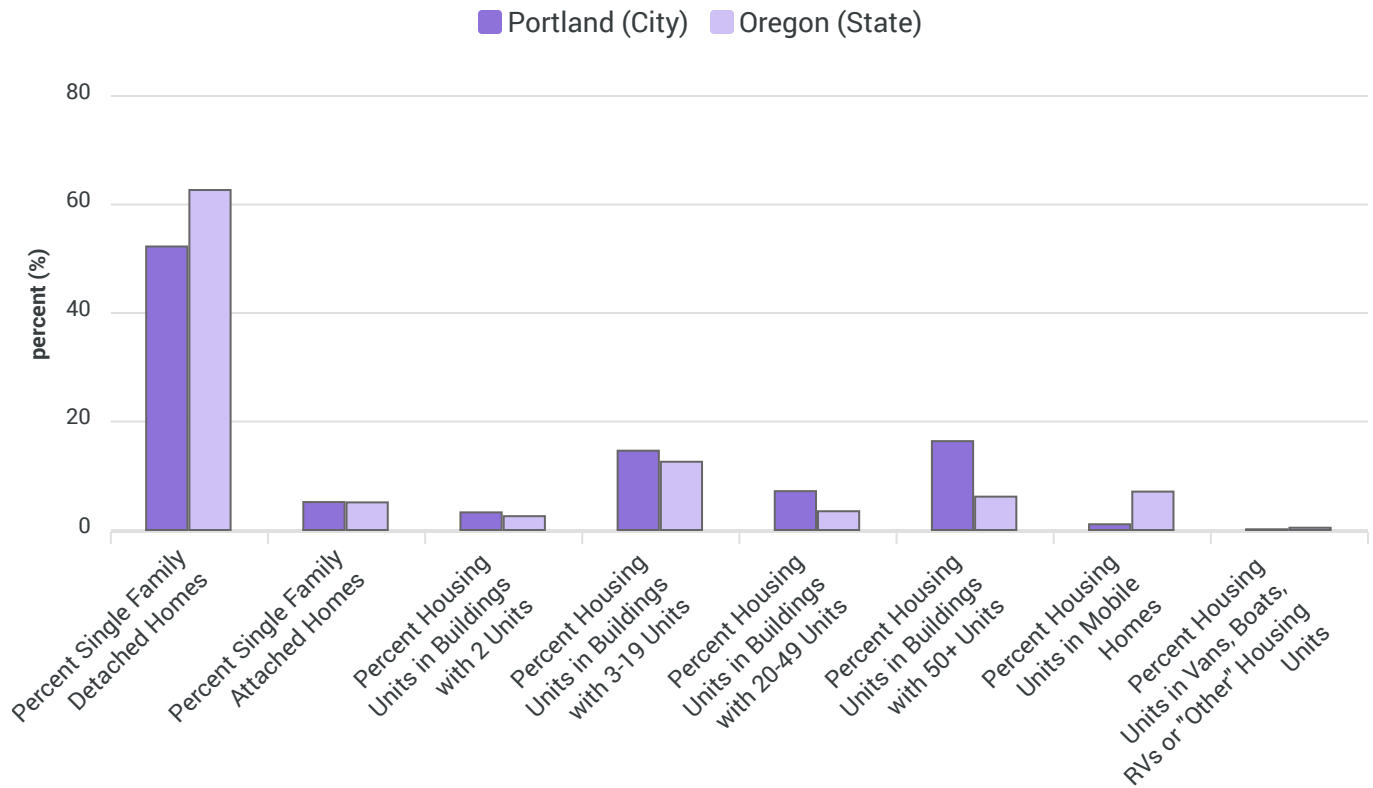

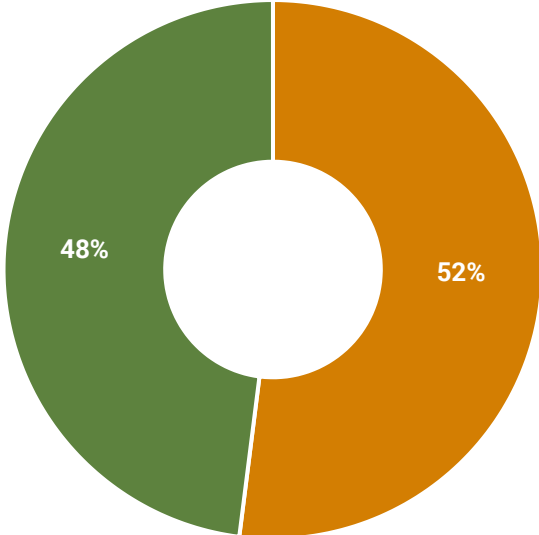
Housing Type 2020-2024



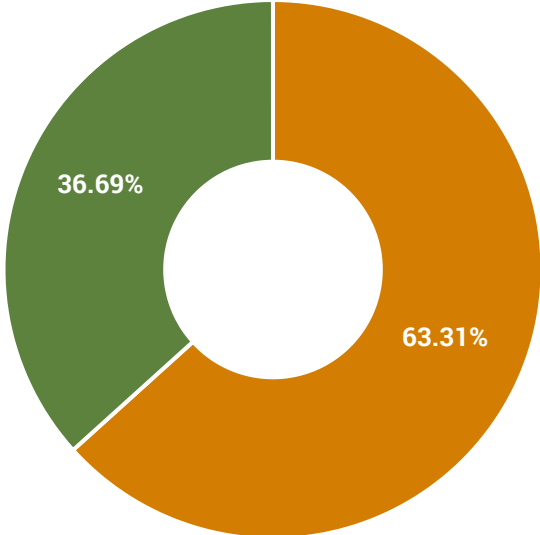

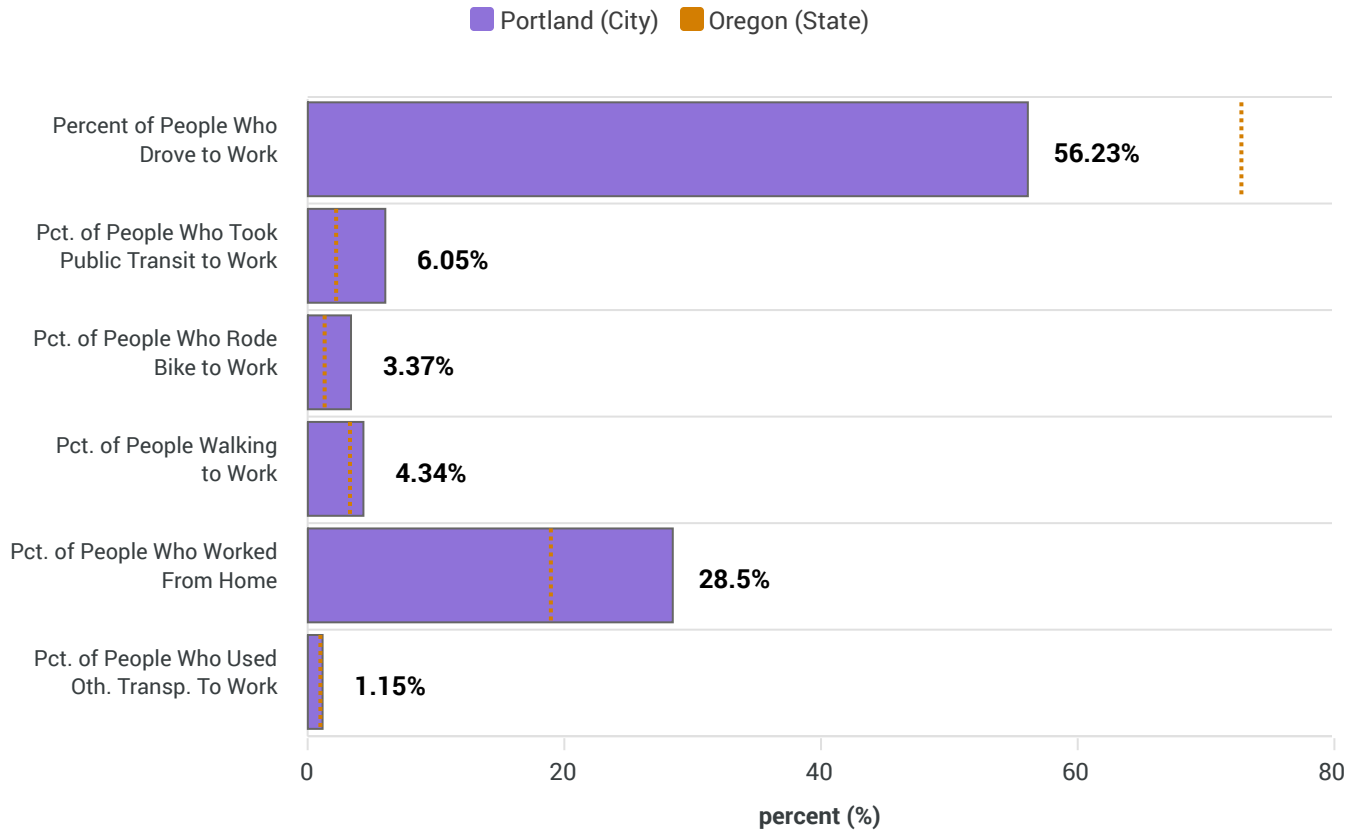


- Homeownership Rate

Endnotes
