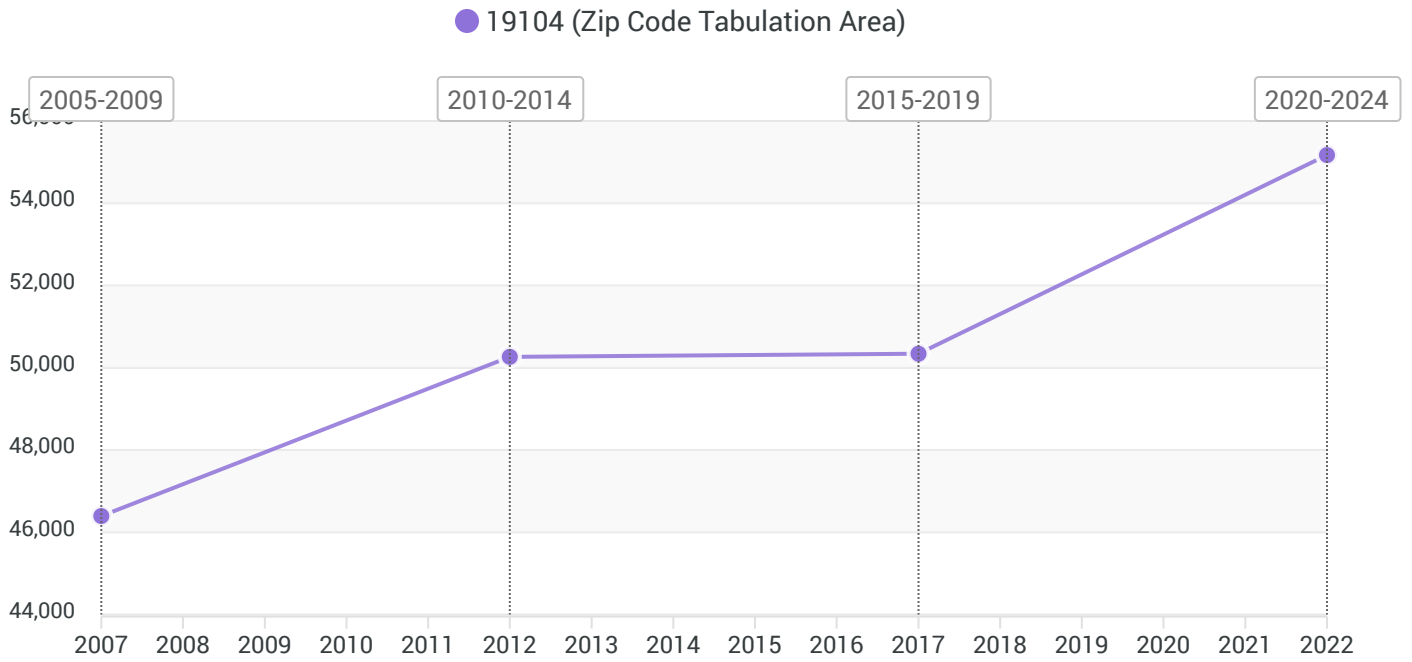

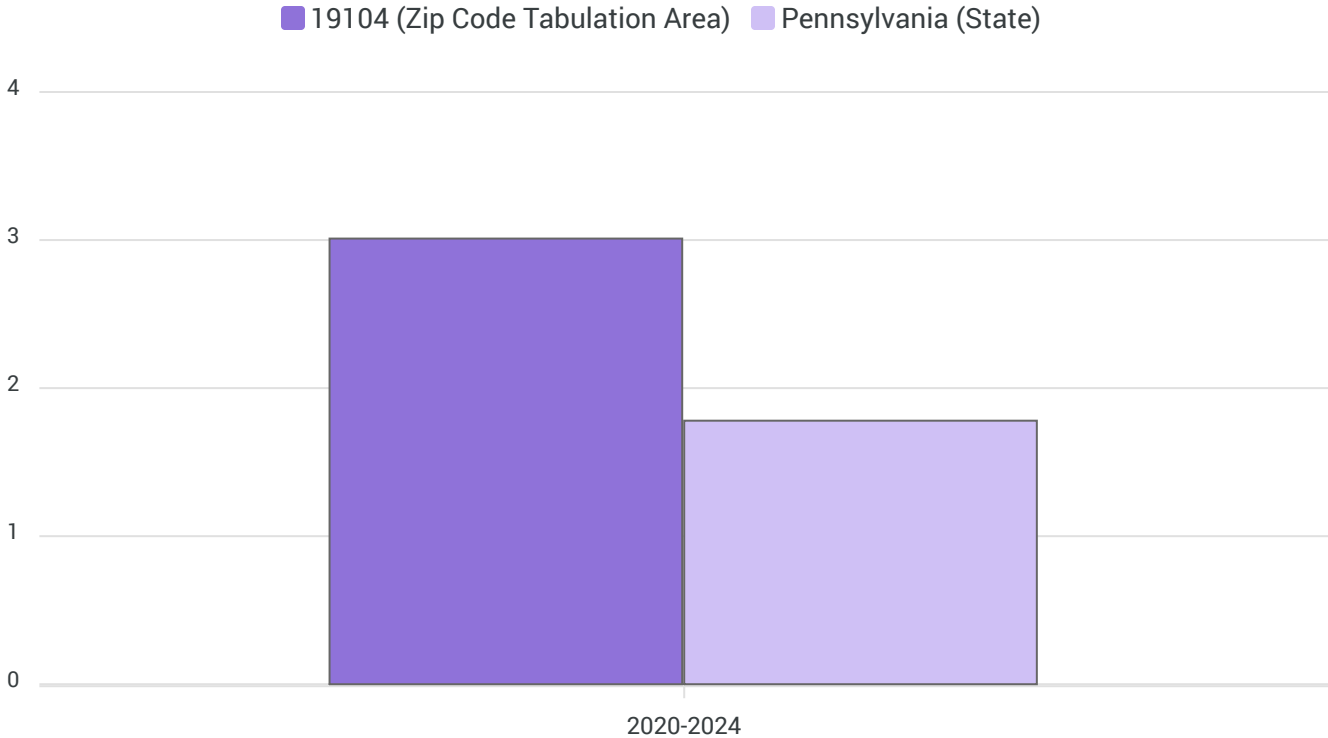

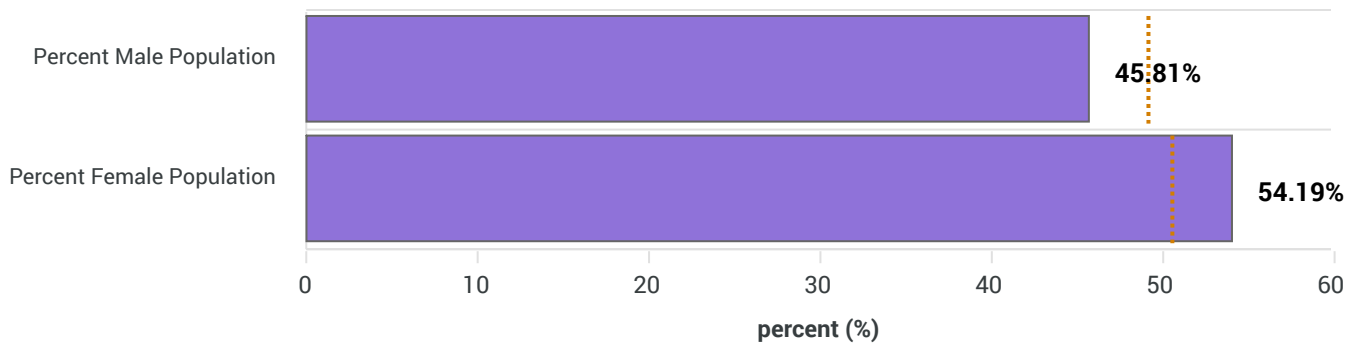

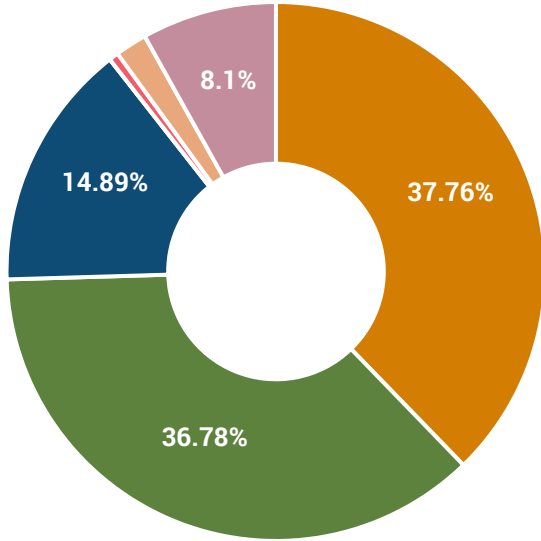

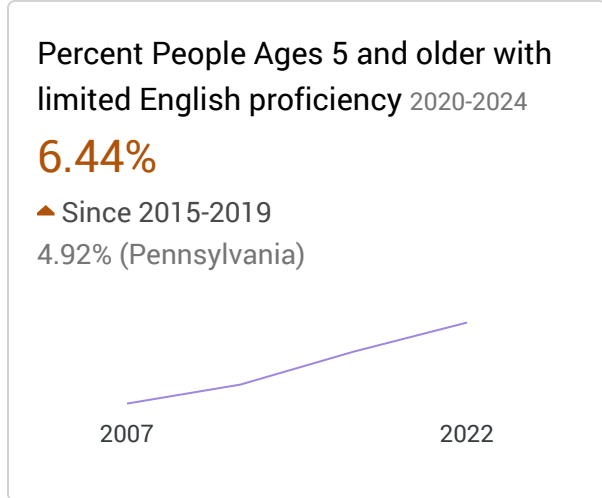

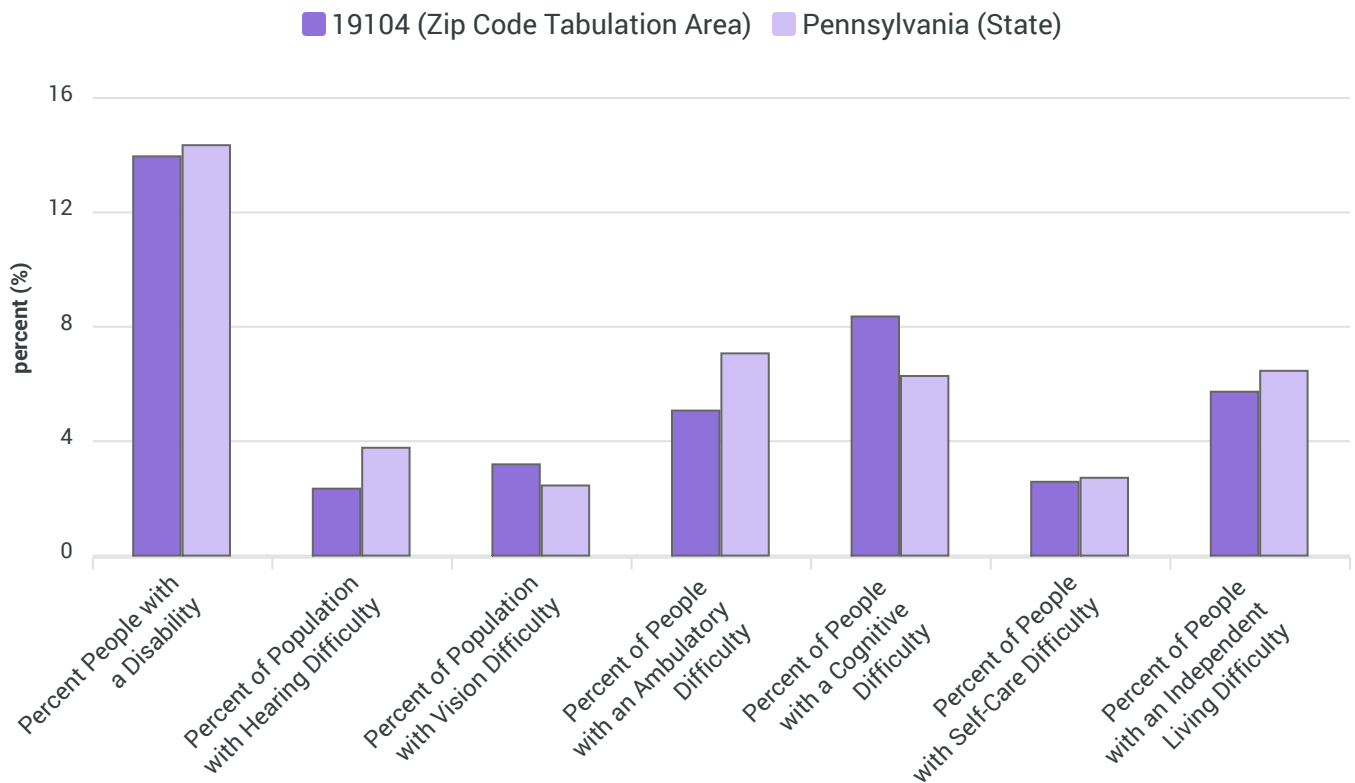

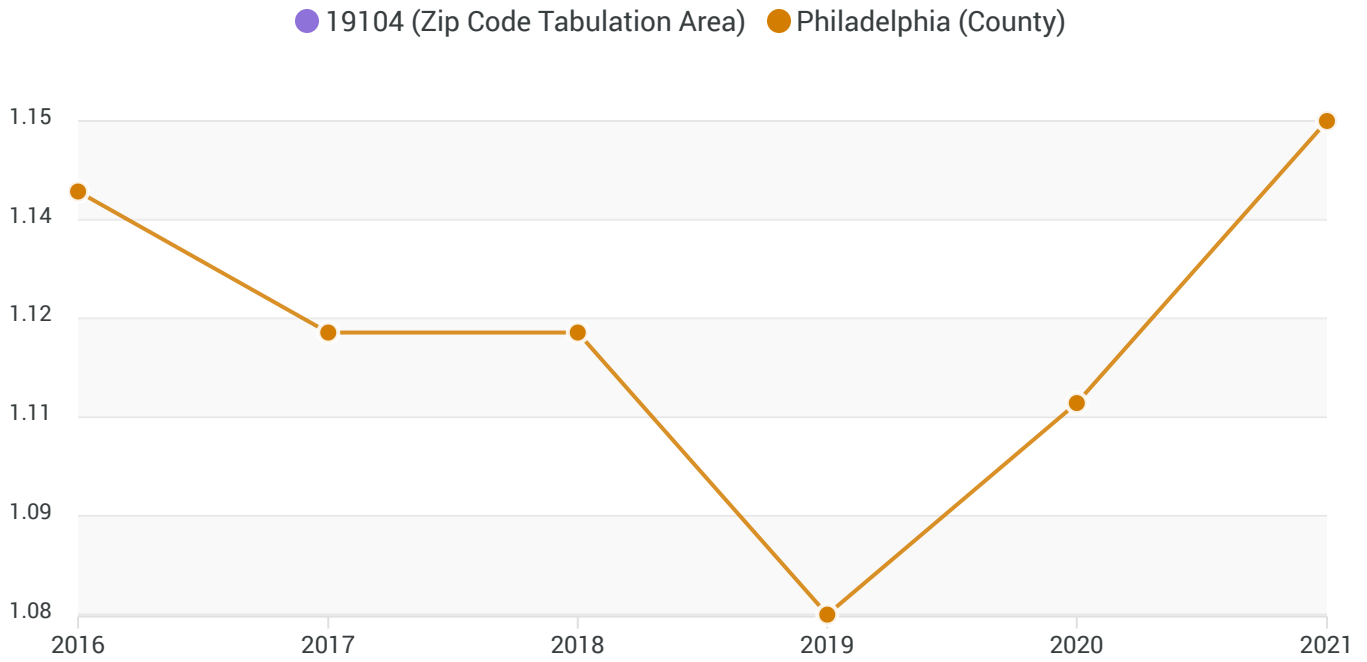
People with Disabilities 2020-2024

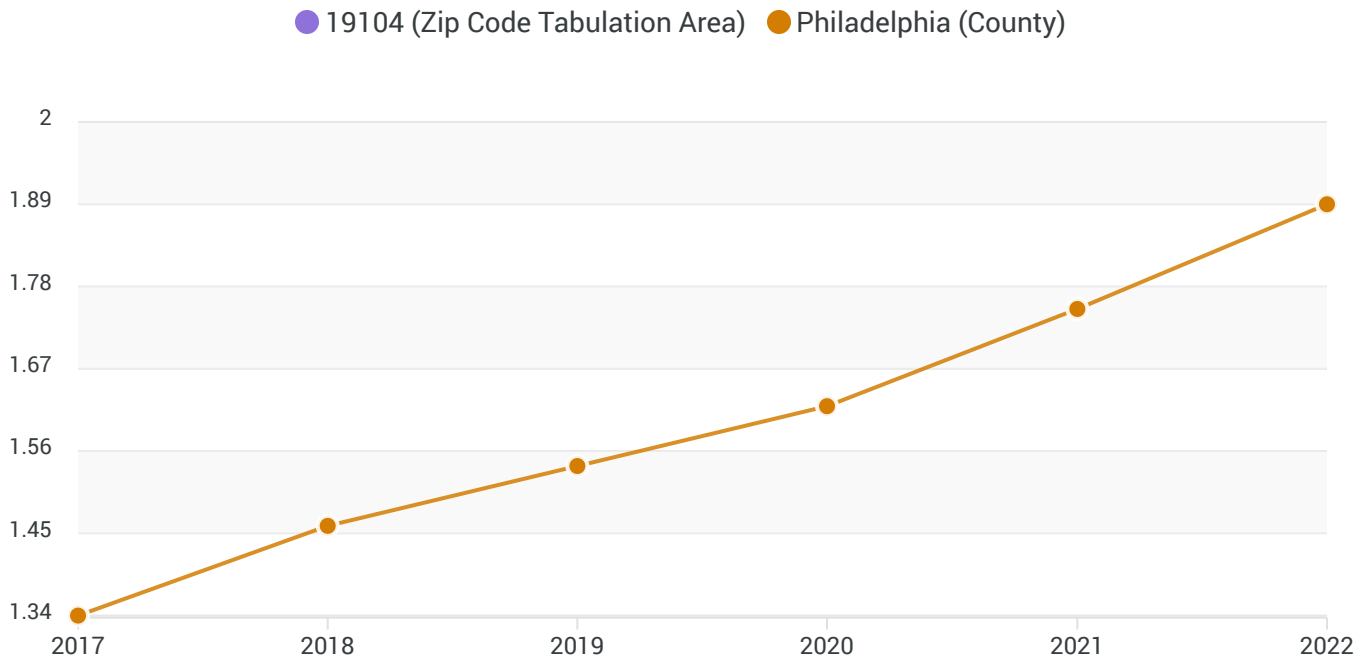
Primary Care Physicians

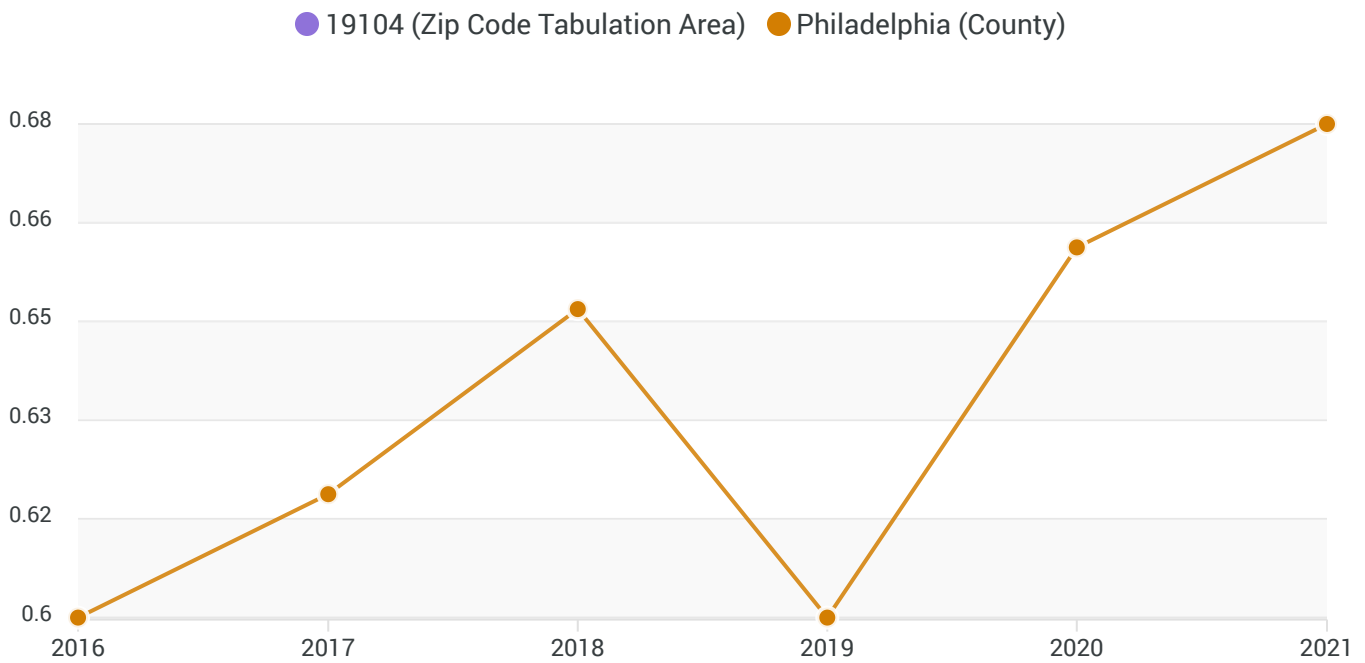

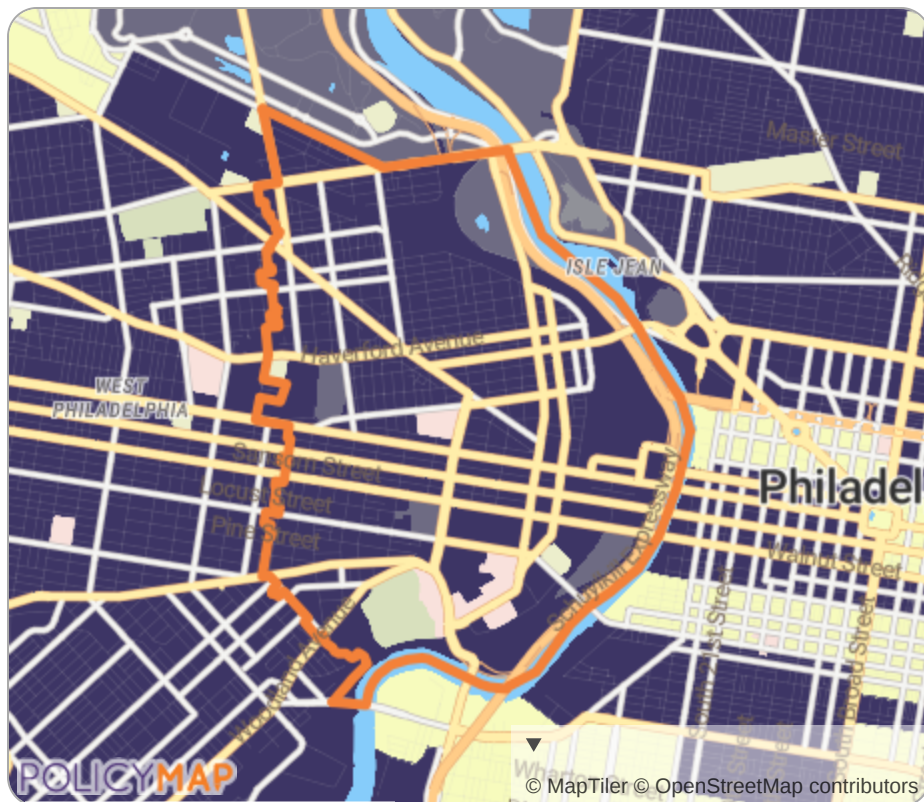

Medically Underserved Areas 2025

Medically Underserved Areas (MUA) are federally designated areas with too few primary care providers, high poverty, high infant mortality, or a high elderly population. Medically Underserved Populations (MUP) reflect groups facing economic, cultural, or linguistic barriers to primary care. Areas or populations that don't meet standard criteria may still receive designation if exceptional barriers exist and a state governor recommends it.

Health Professional Shortage Areas 2025

Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSAs) are areas designated by HRSA as lacking adequate primary care, dental, or mental health providers. Designations consider three factors: the local provider-to-population ratio, the share of residents living in poverty, and how far residents must travel to find care elsewhere.

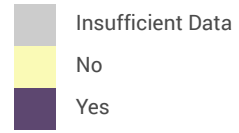

Rural Status 2025



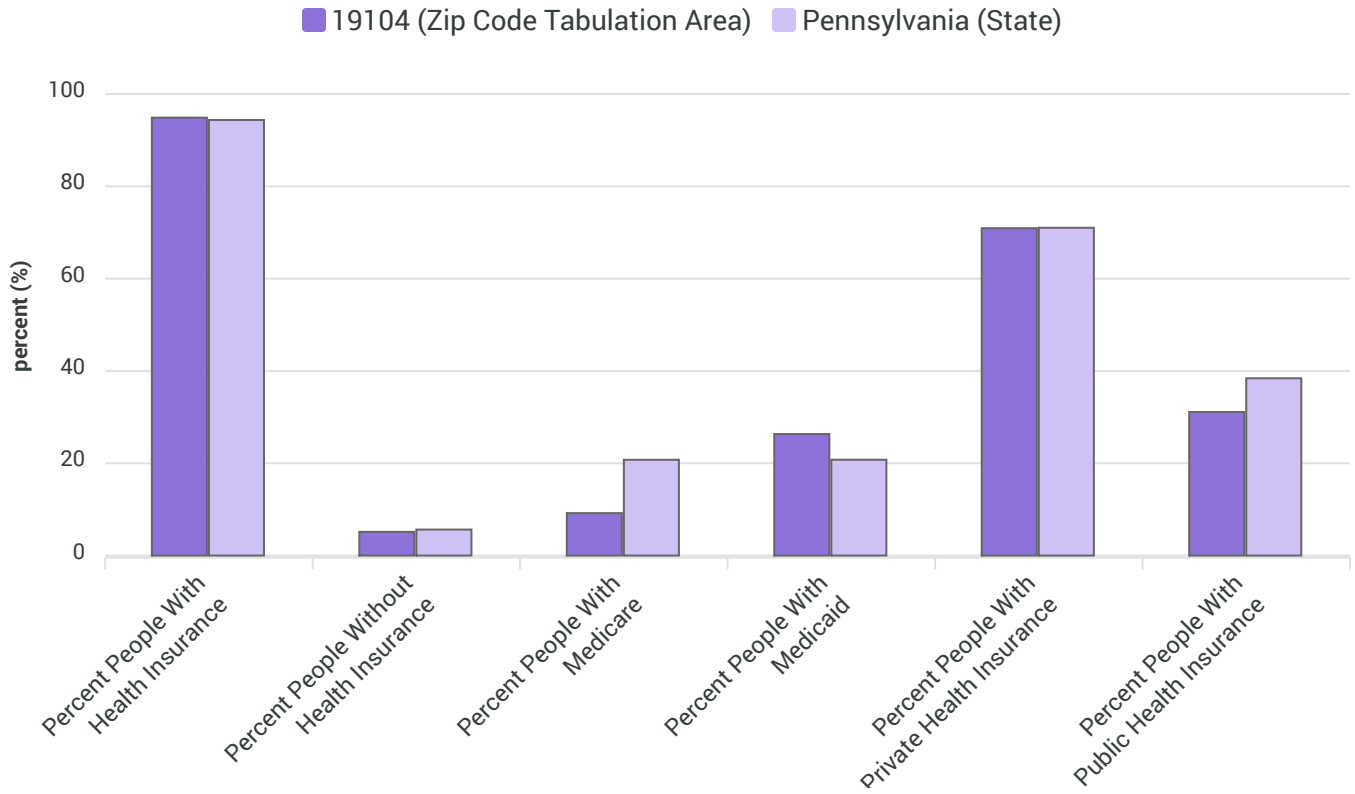

Health Insurance Coverage 2020-2024



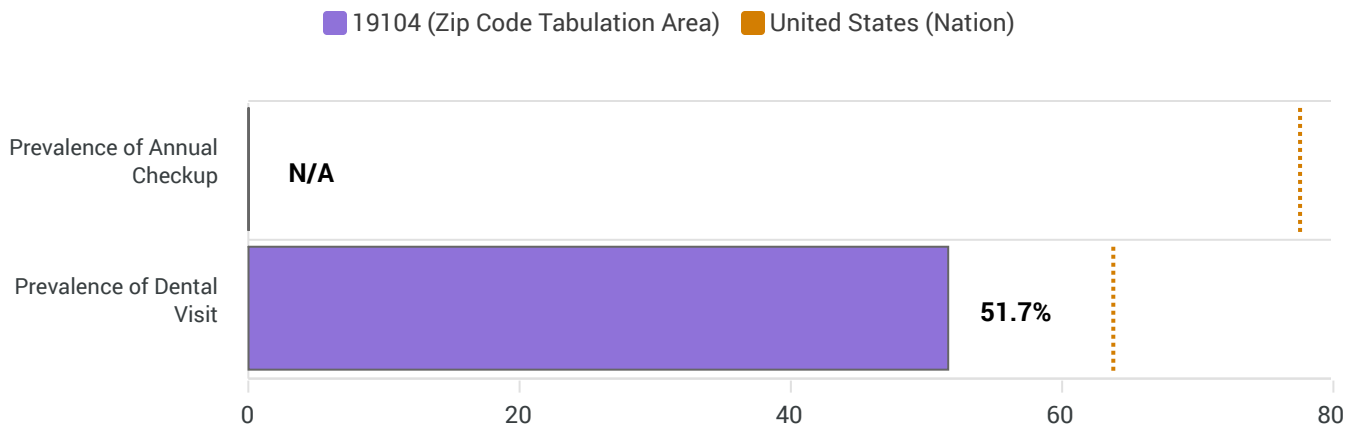

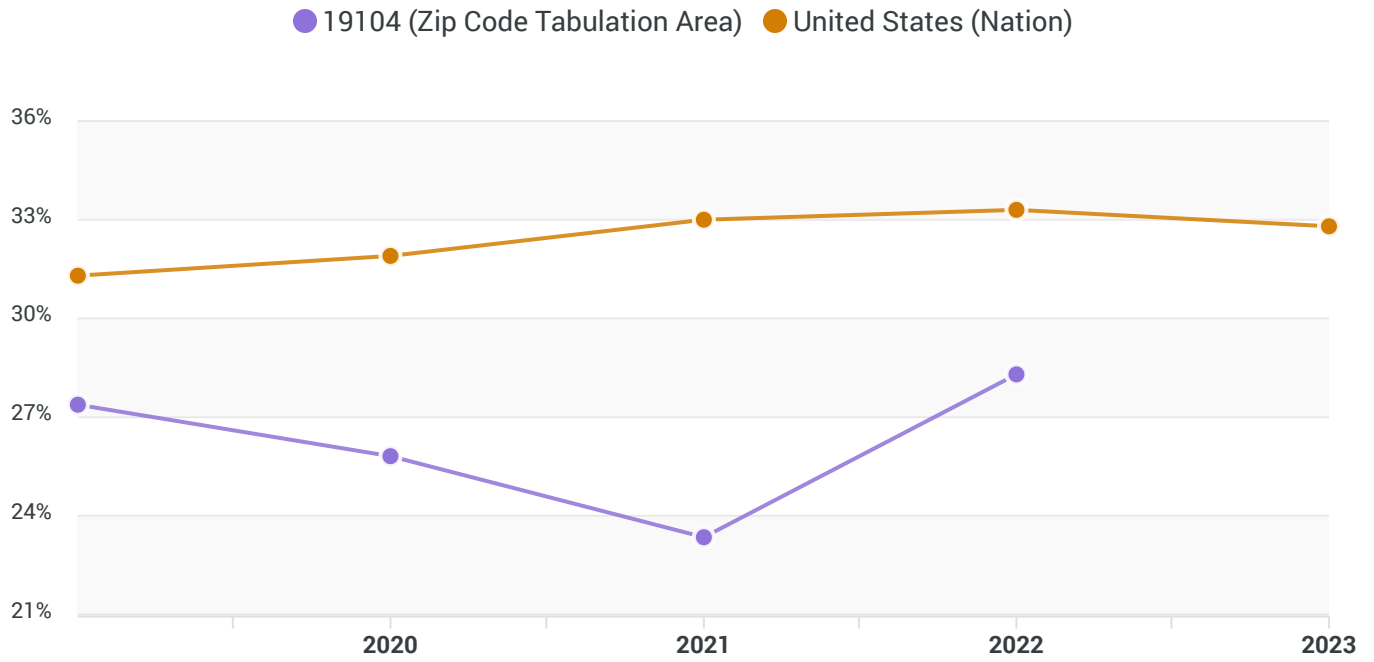

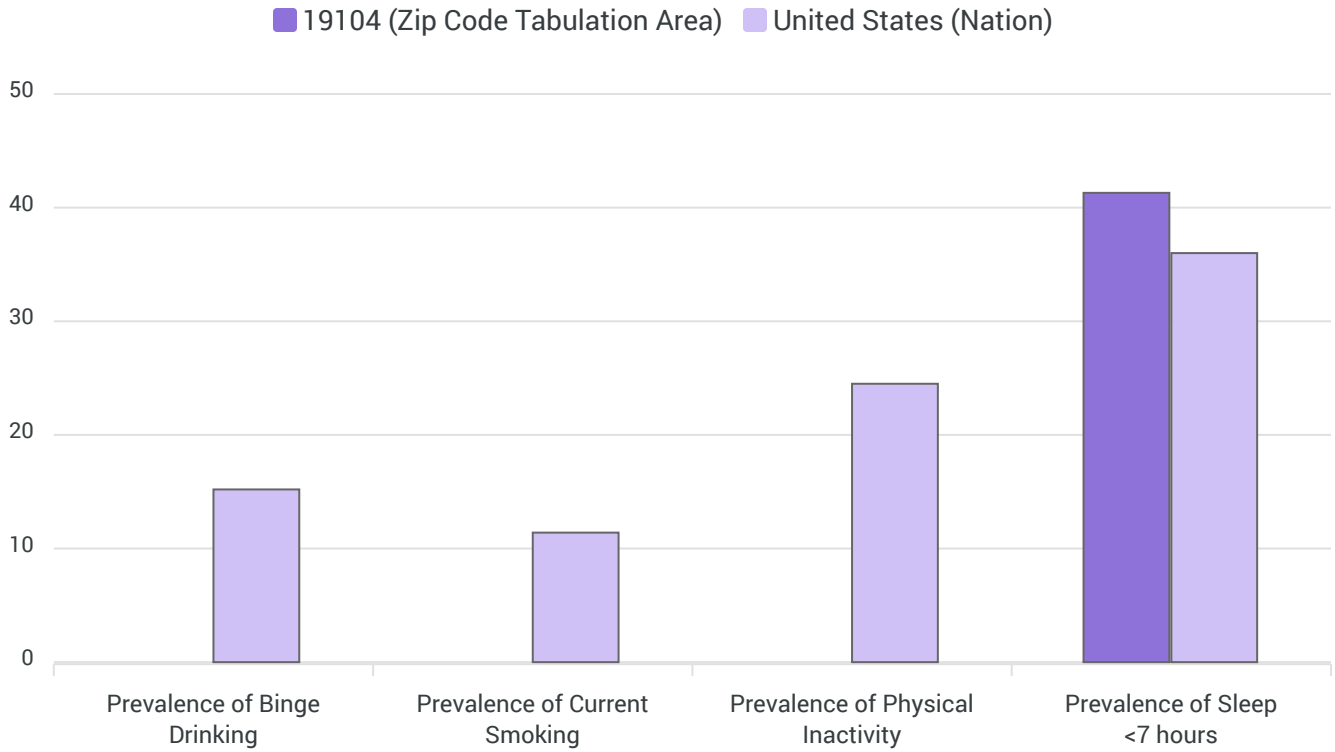

Prevalence of Loneliness 2023

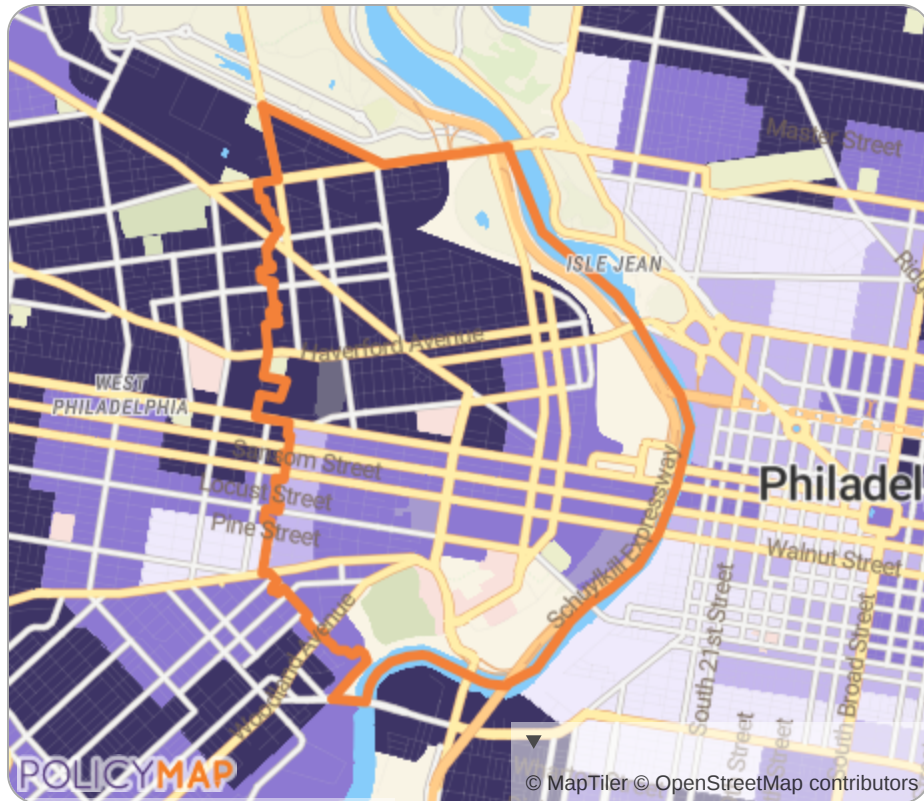

Social Vulnerability Index 2022

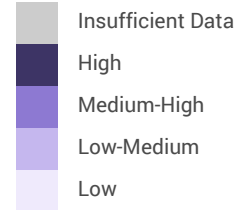

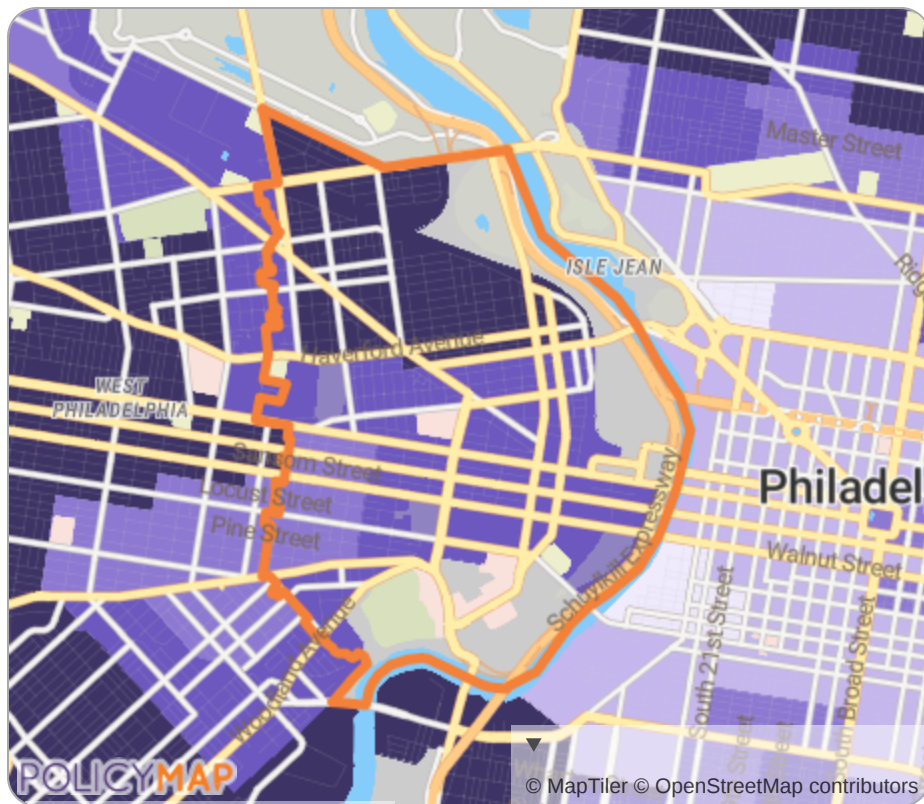

Maternal Vulnerability Index 2024

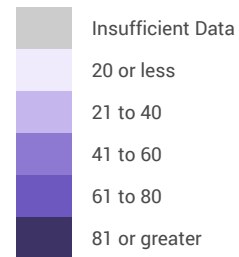

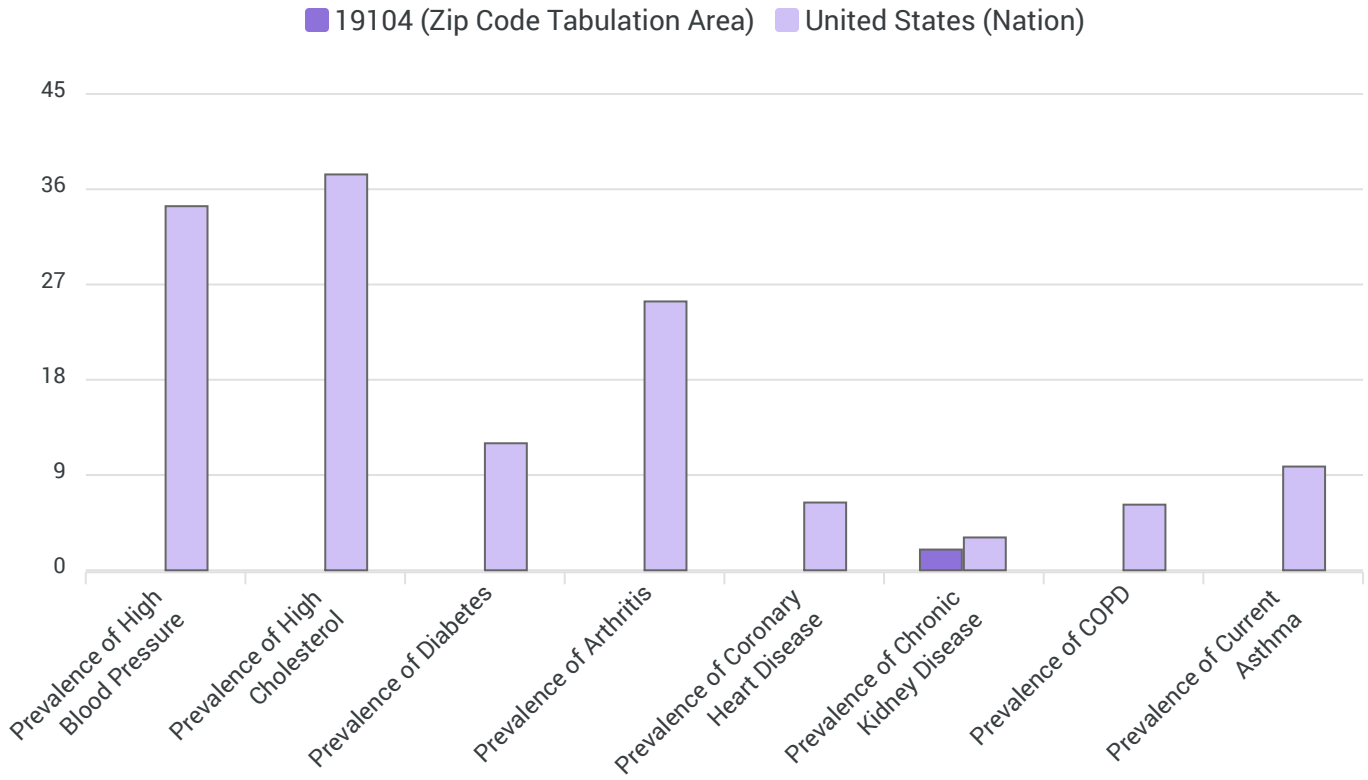

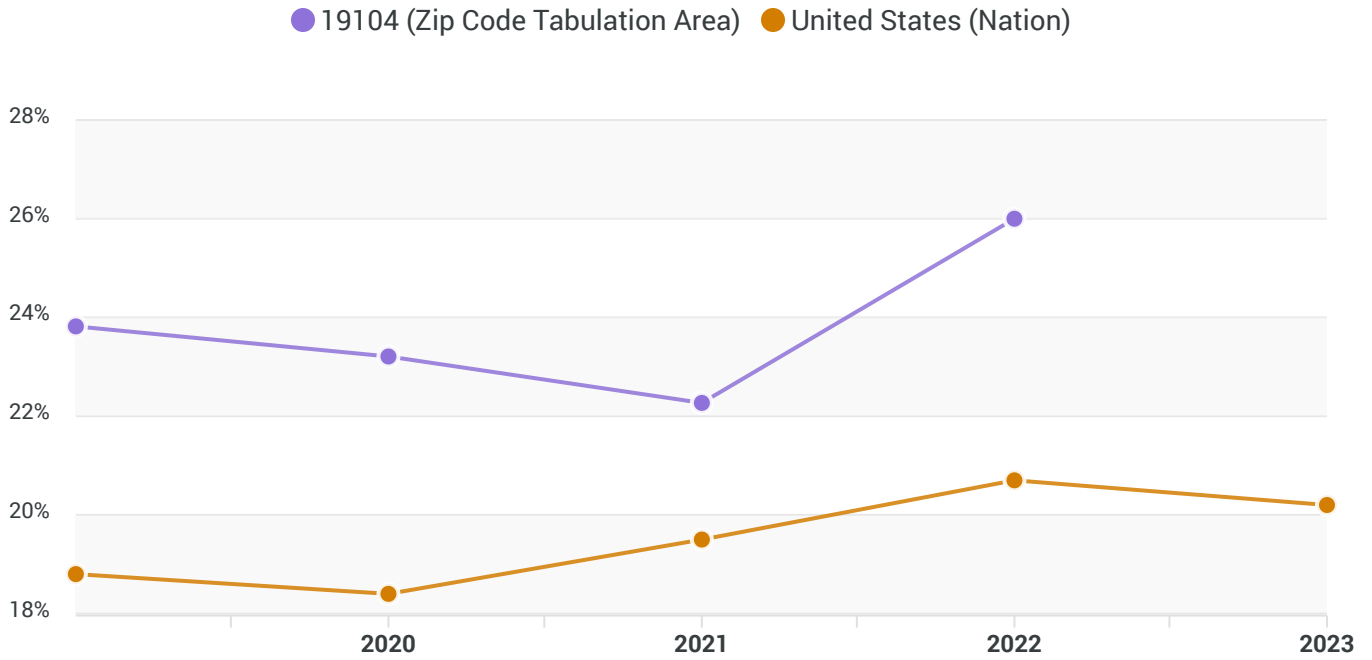

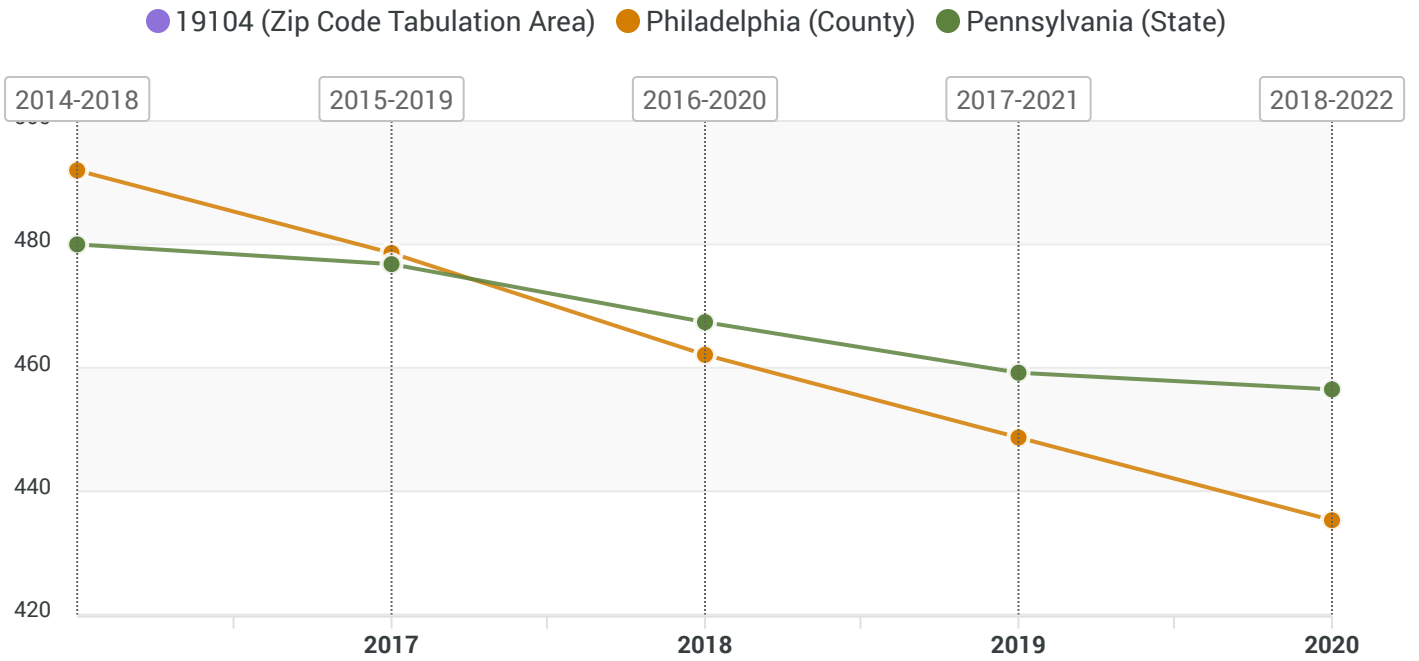

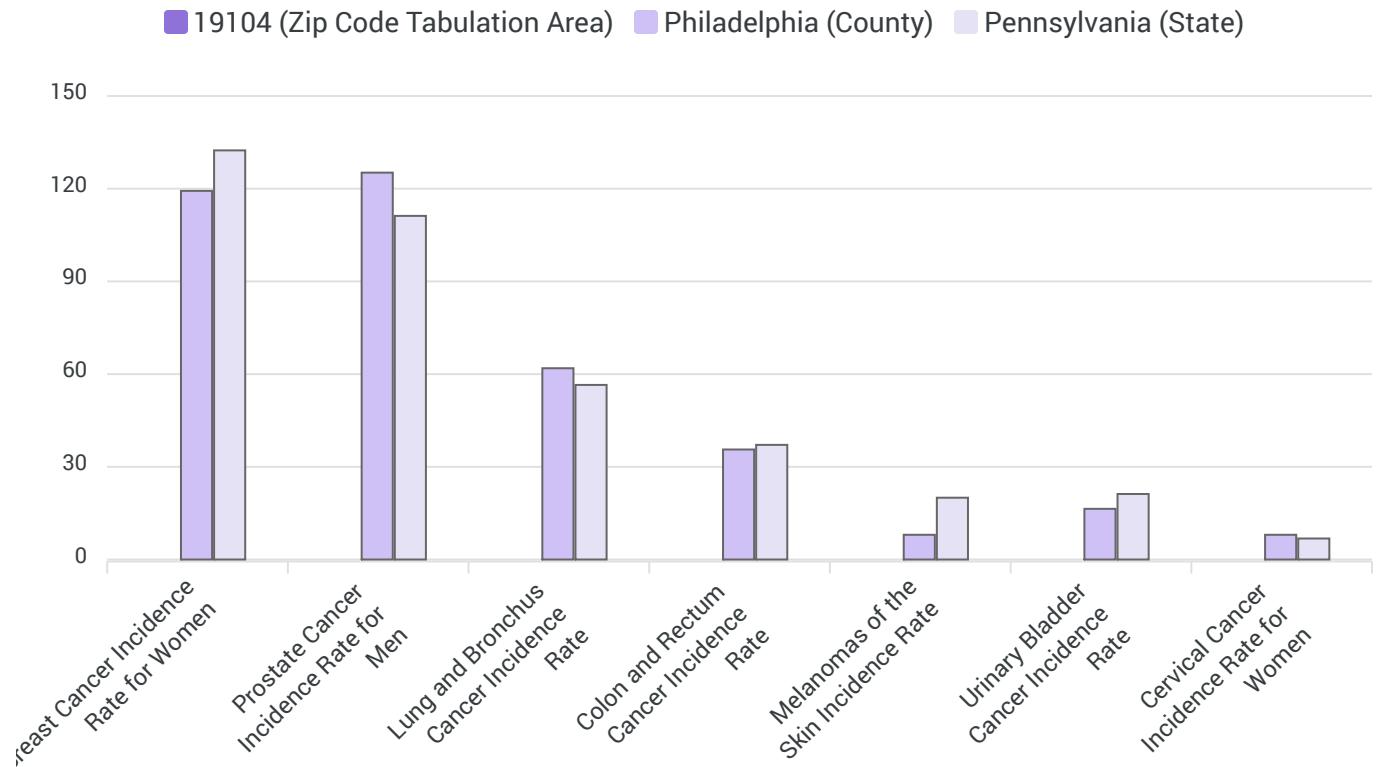
Cancer Incidence

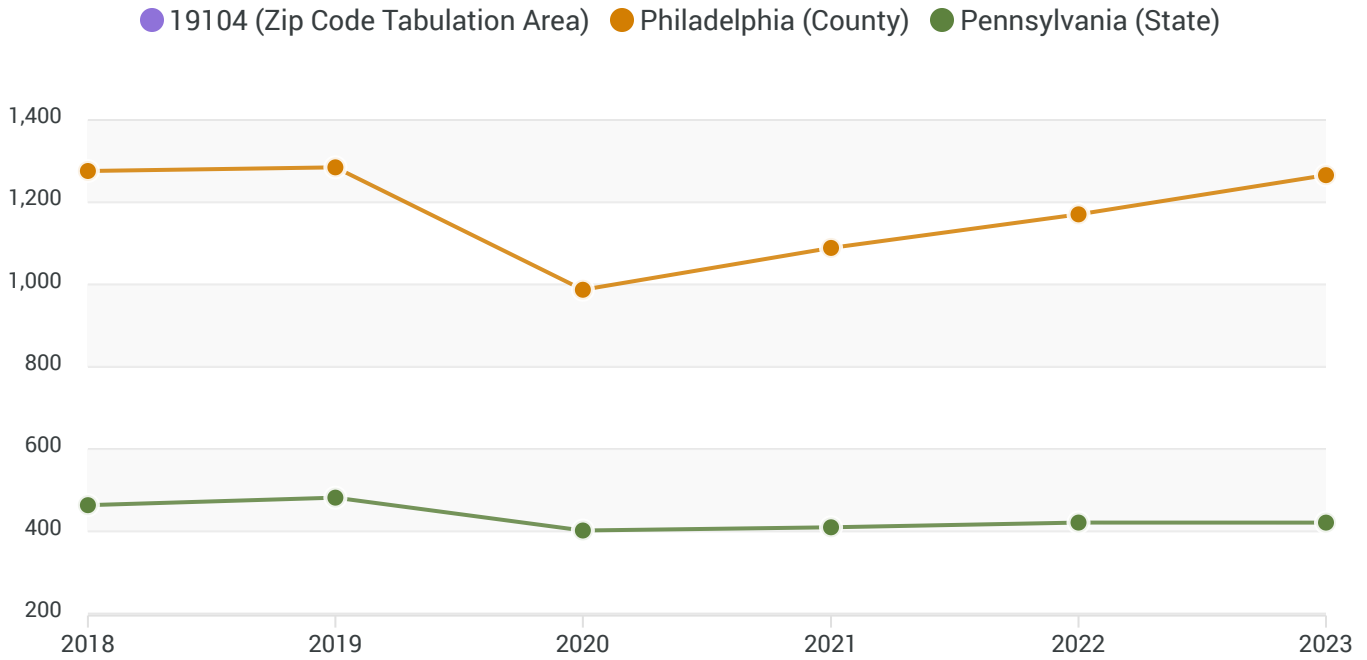

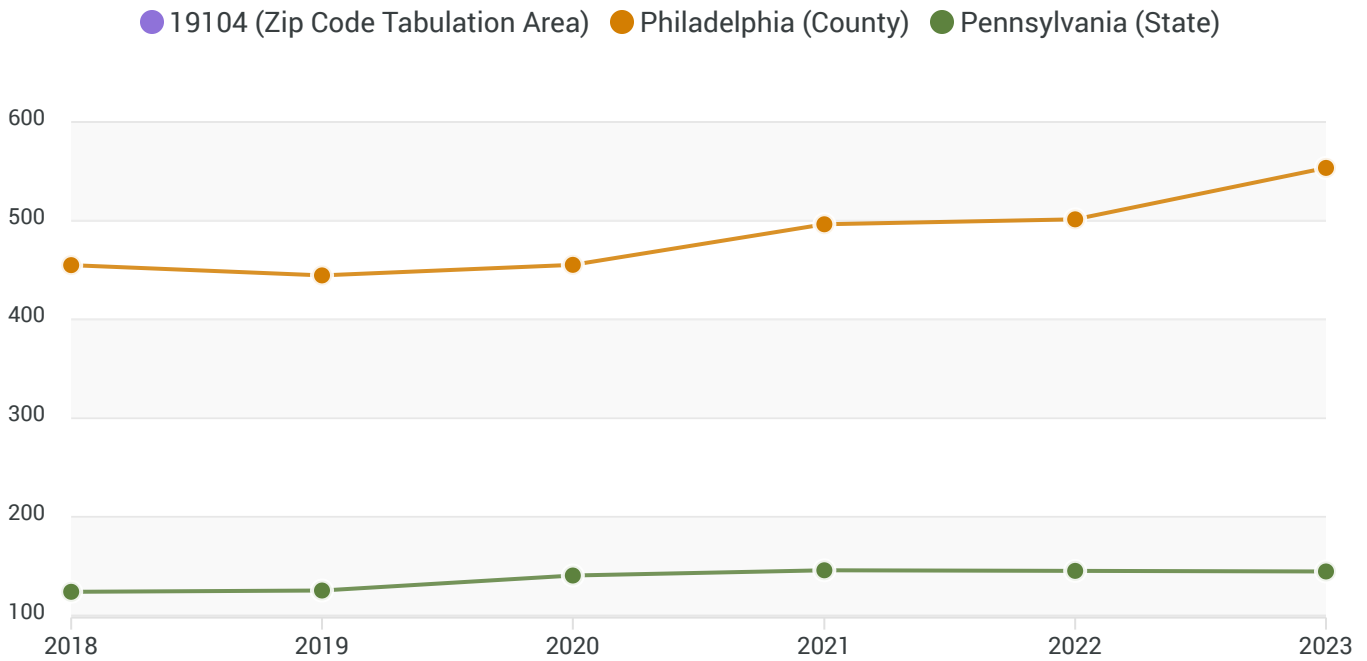

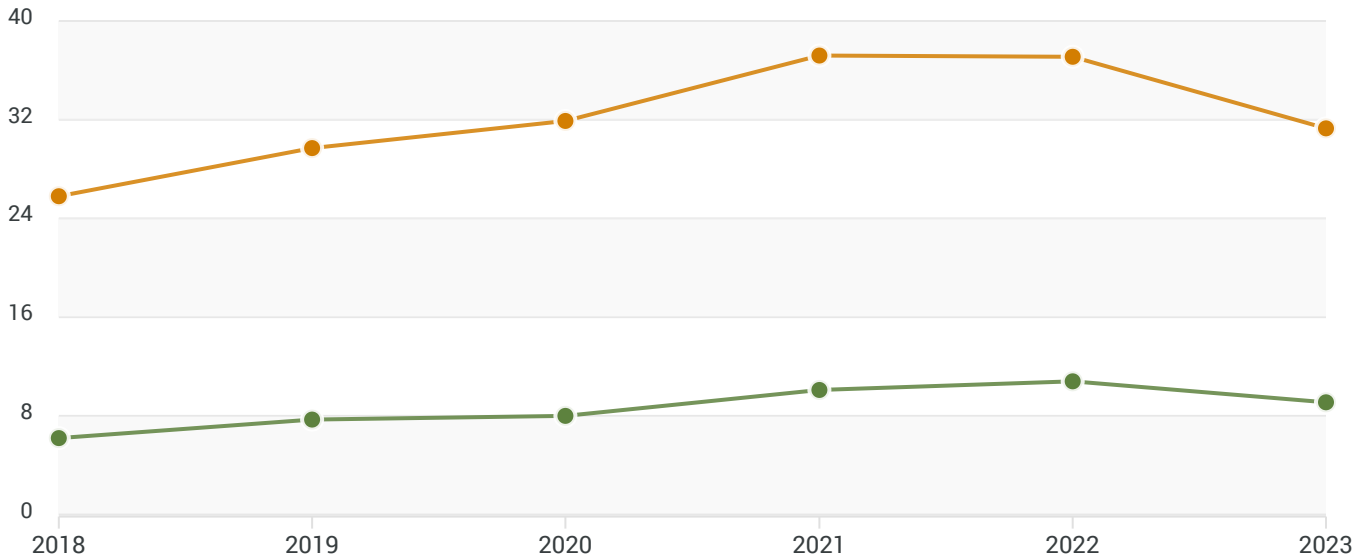

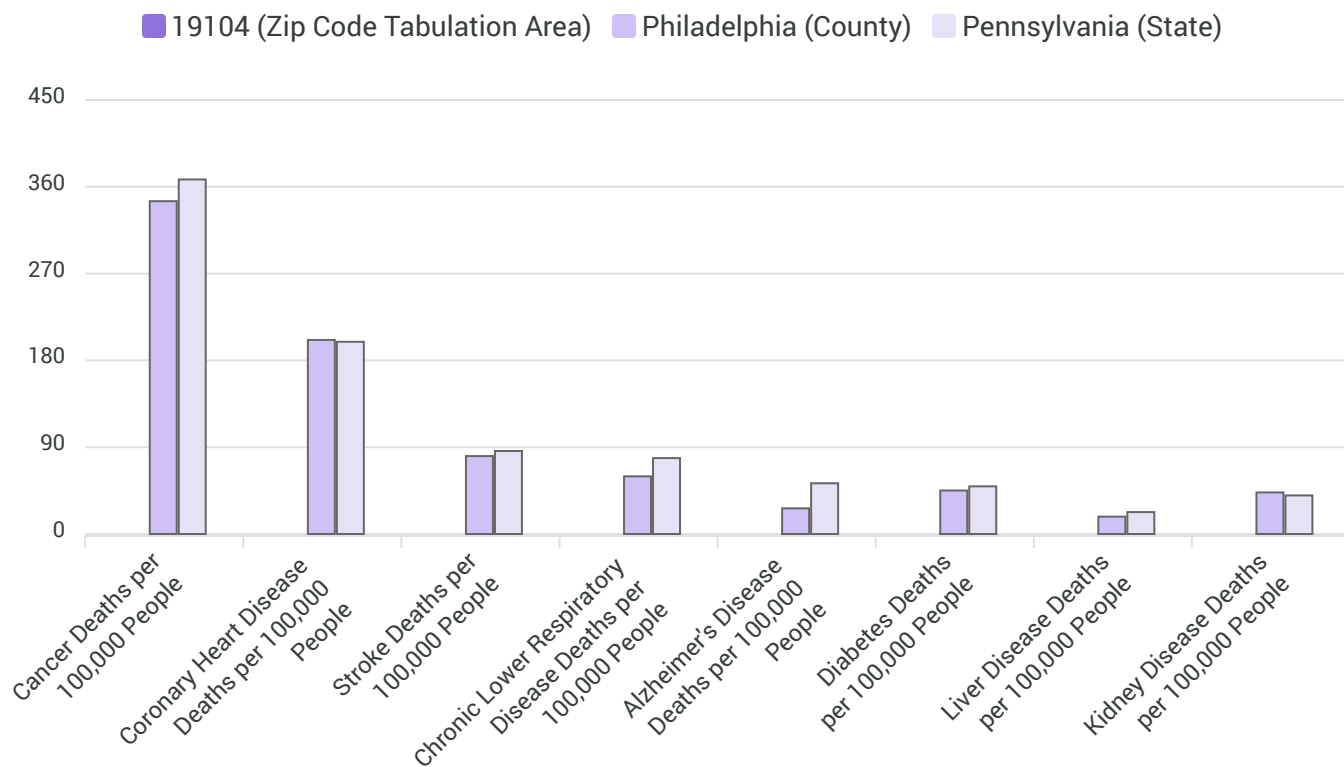

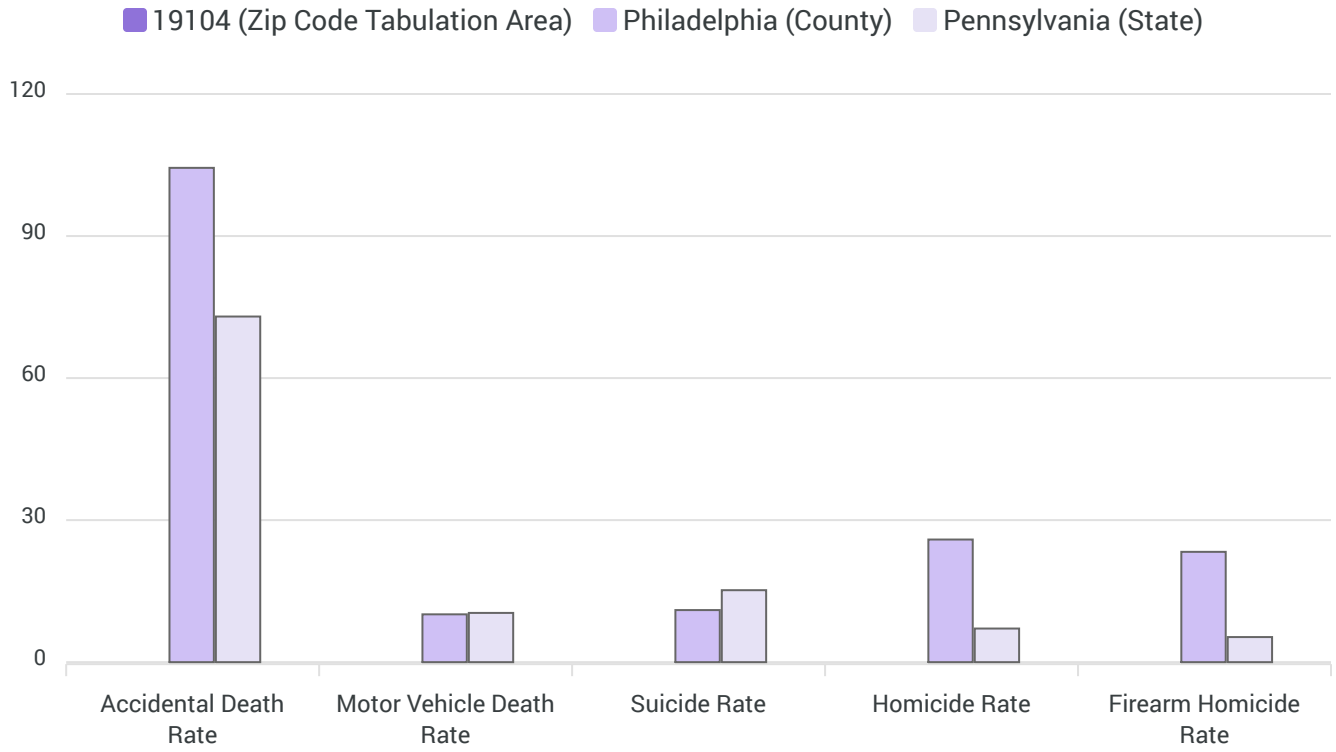

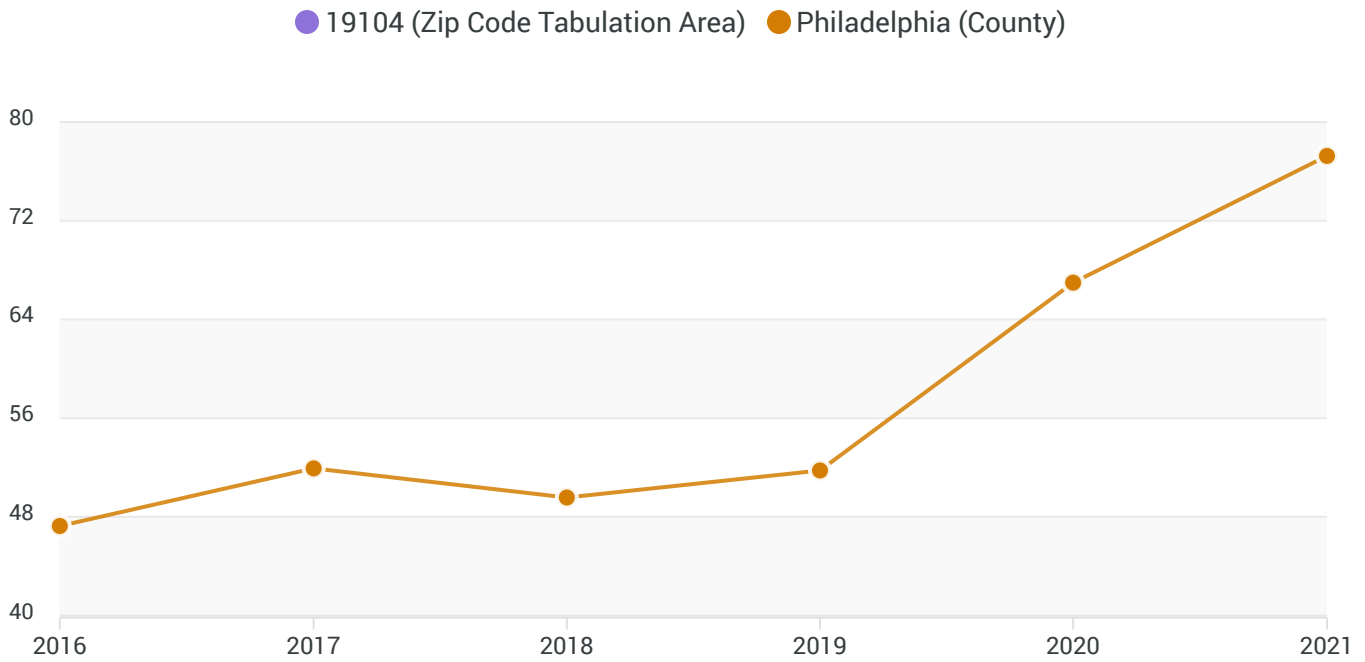
Injury-Related Mortality 2023

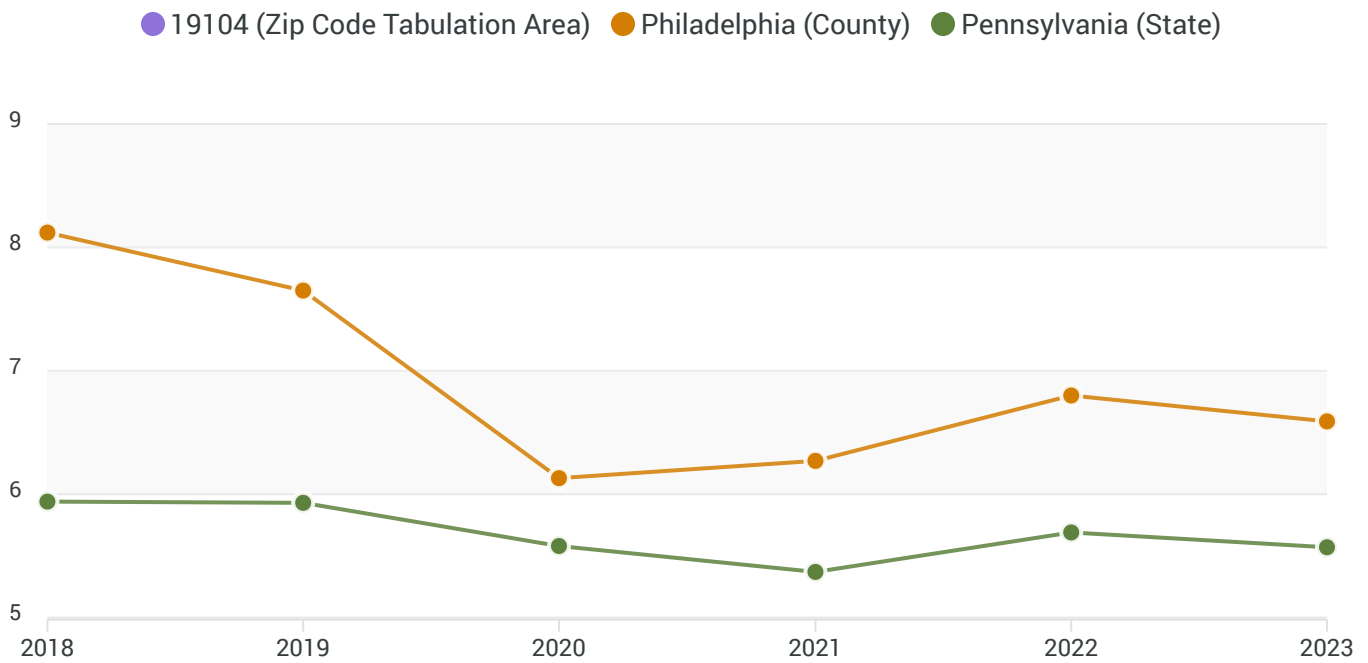
Drug Overdose Deaths

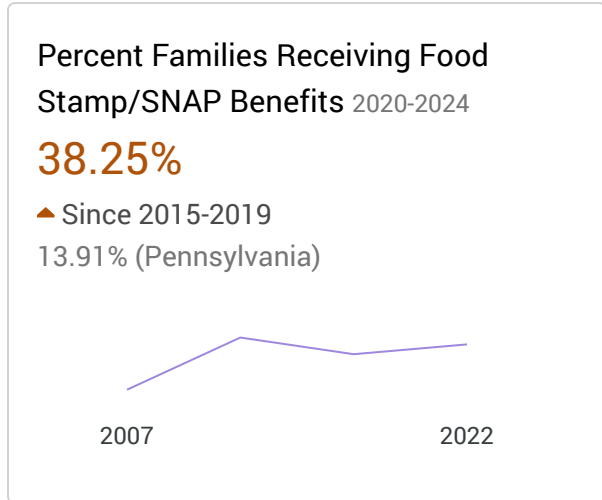
Limited Supermarket Areas 2022

These designations identify communities where residents travel nearly twice as far to a full-service supermarket as those in areas with similar population density and above-average incomes. They differ by population size and geography: Limited Supermarket Areas (LSAs) cover larger combined block groups while Low-Access/Low-Population and Low-Access/Low-Density Areas capture smaller or more remote communities.

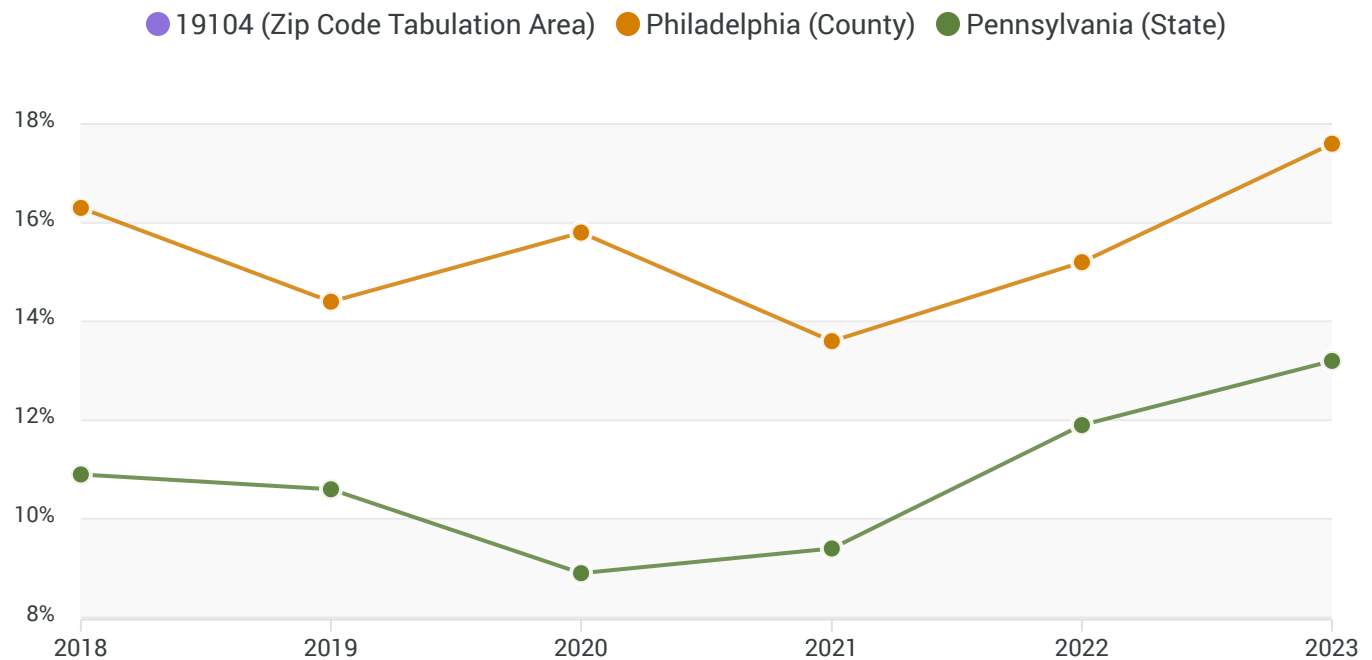

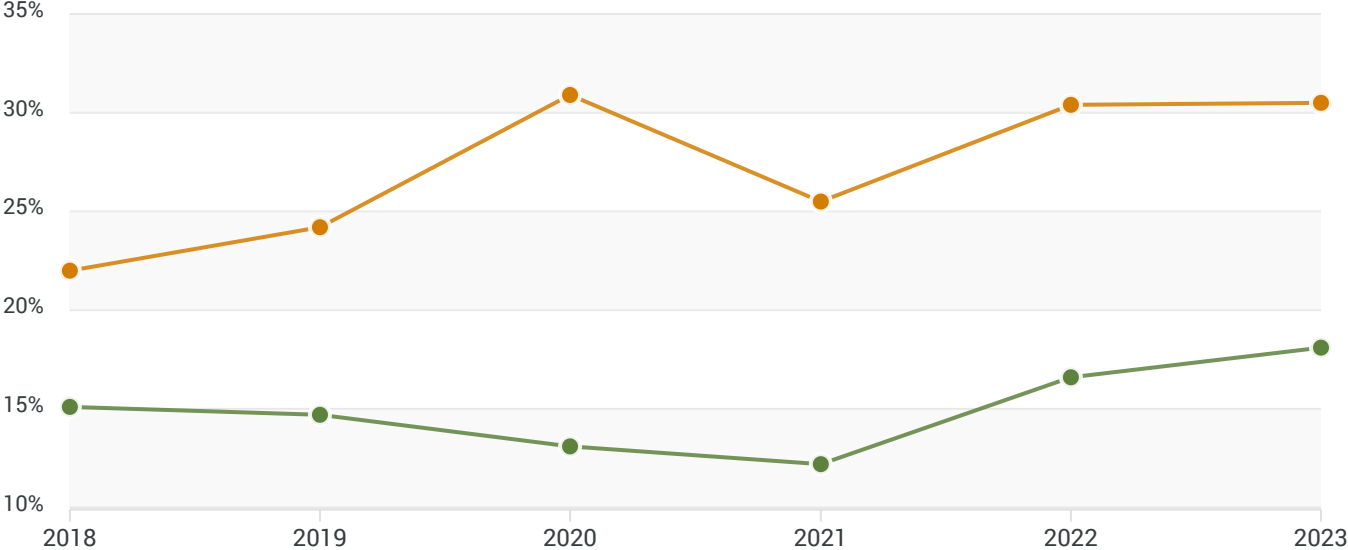

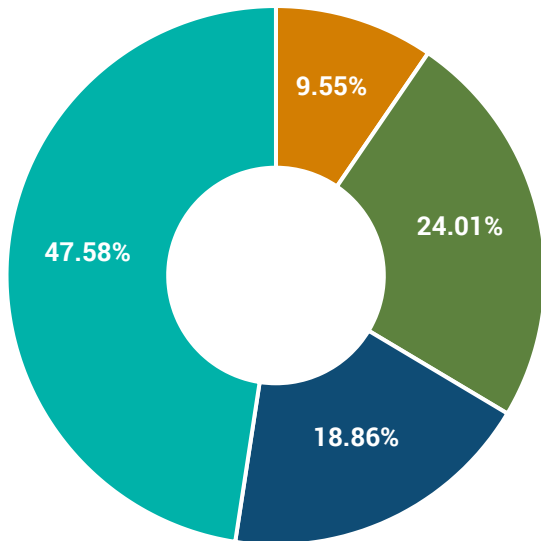

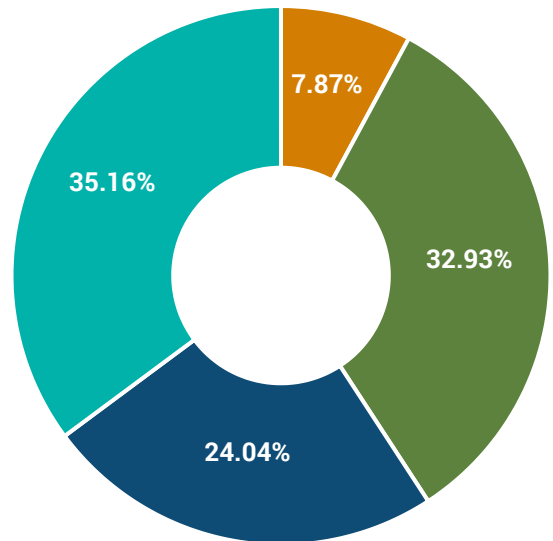

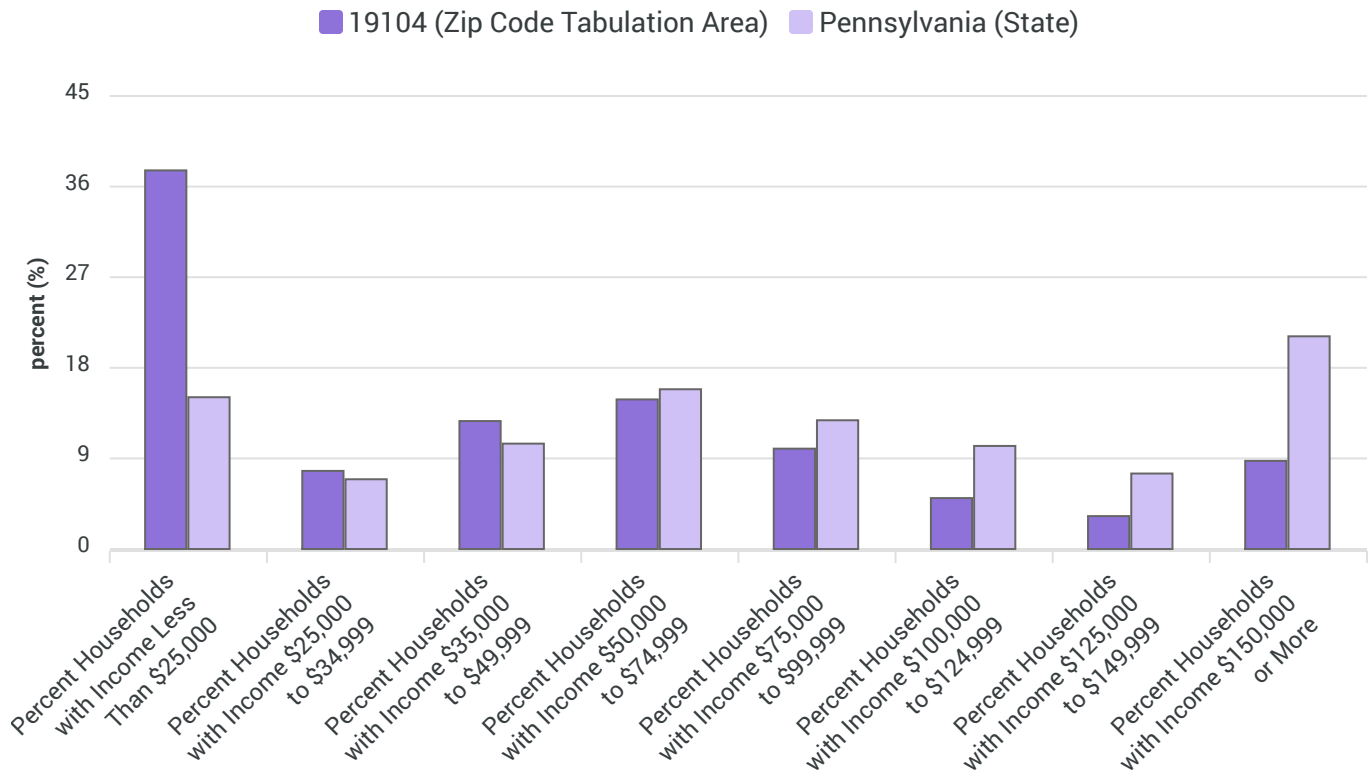

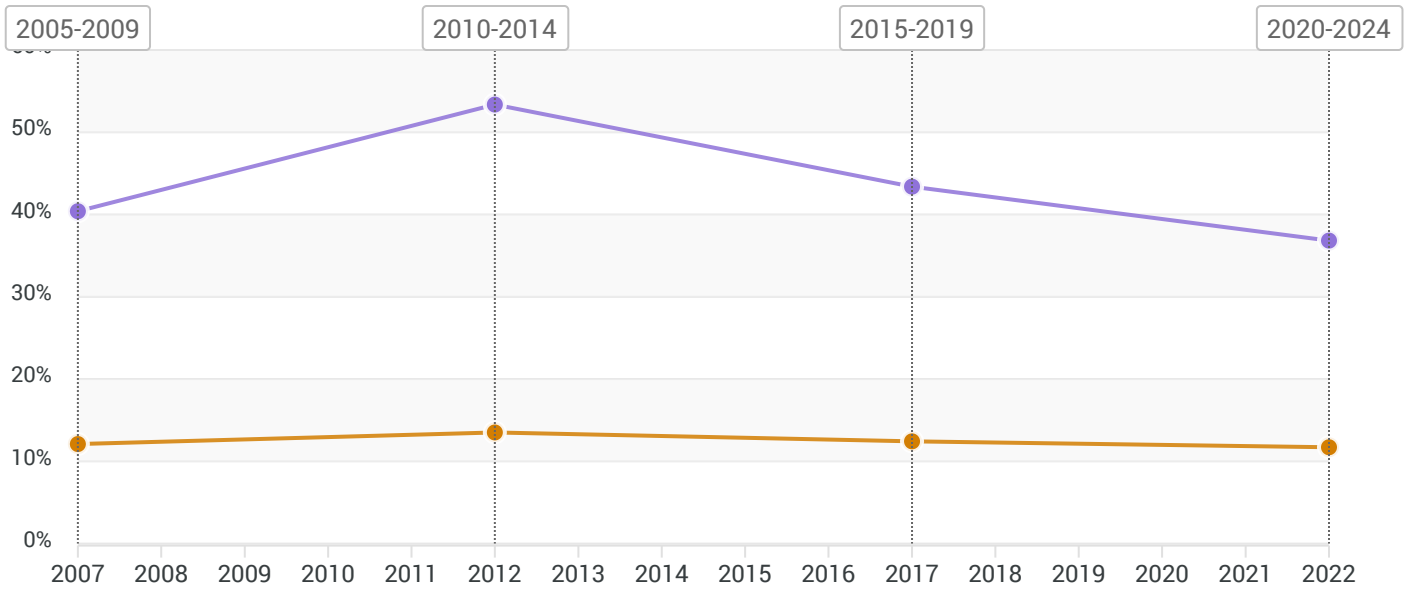
Households by Annual Income 2020-2024

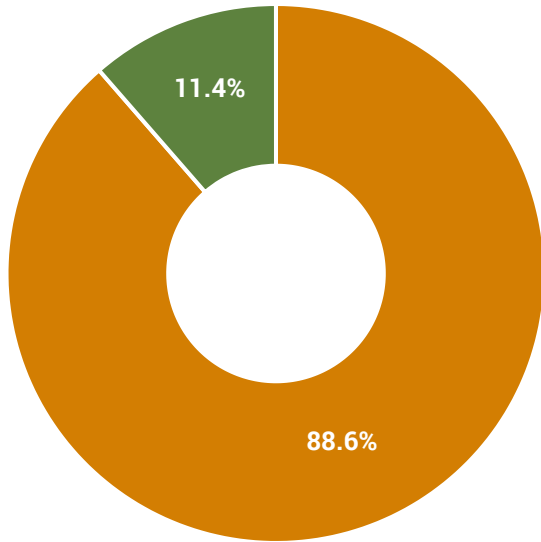

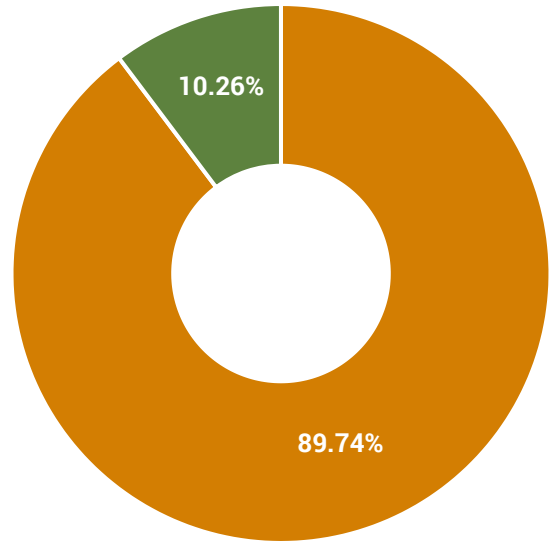

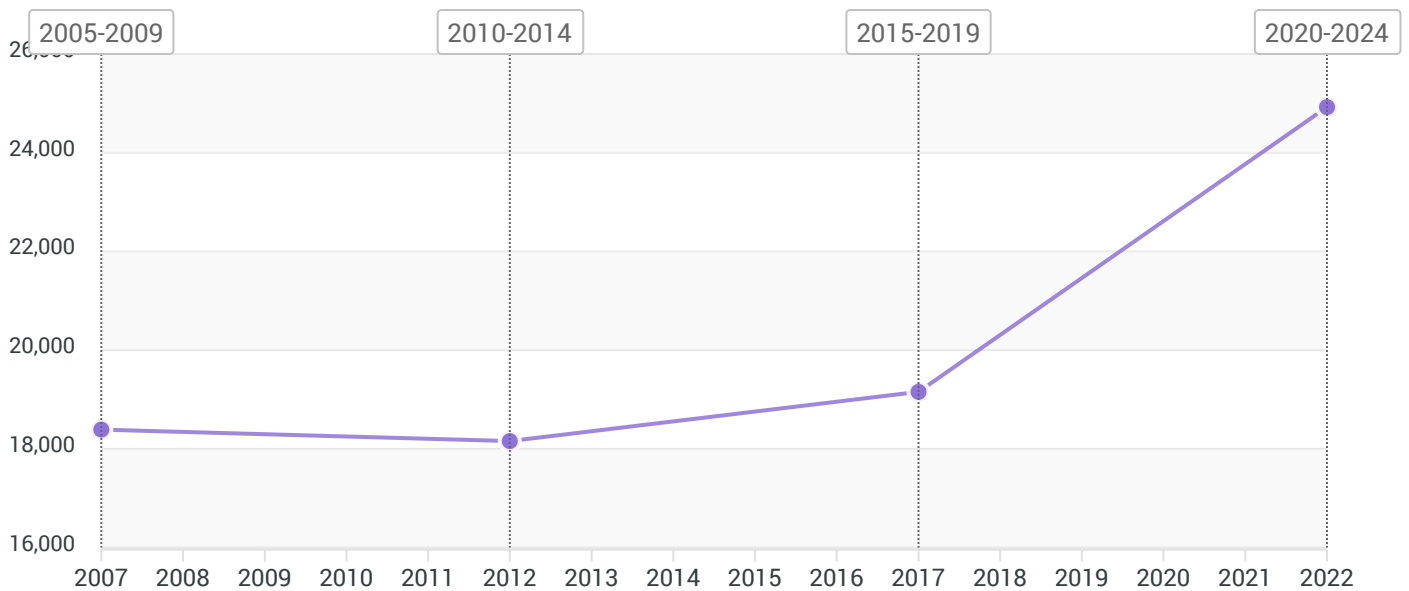

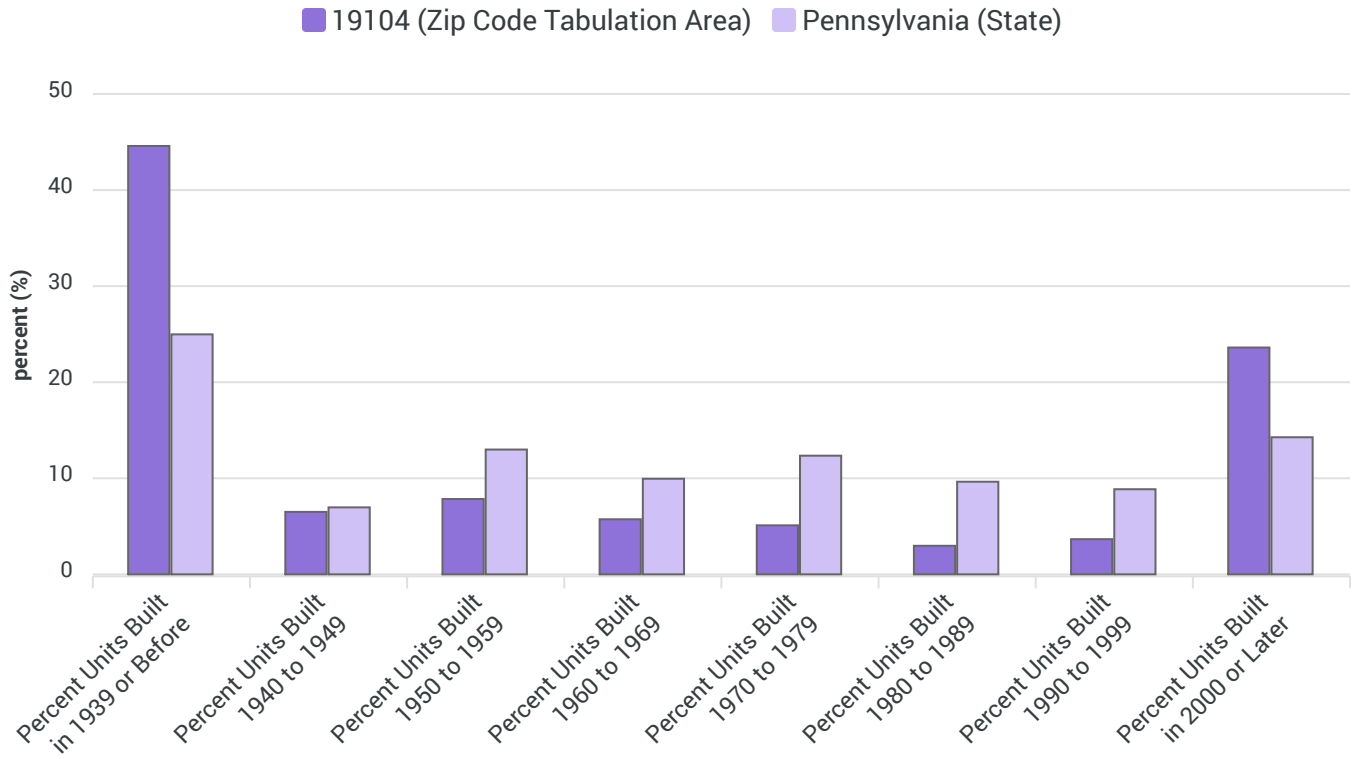

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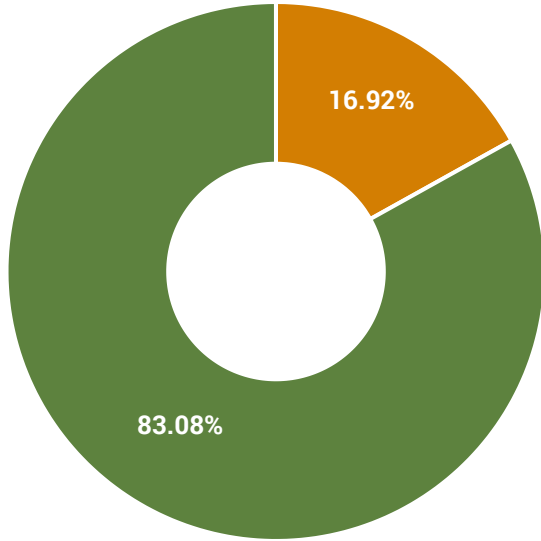
Homes by Year Built 2020-2024



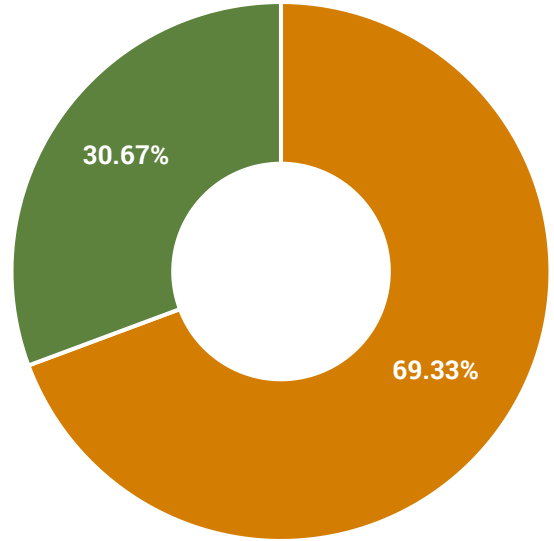

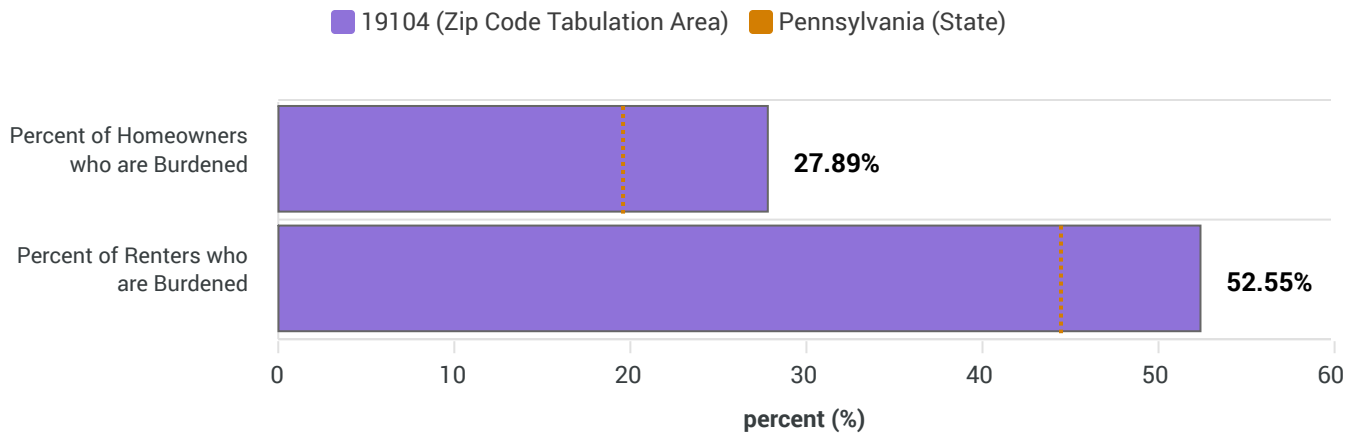

Housing Cost Burdens 2020-2024

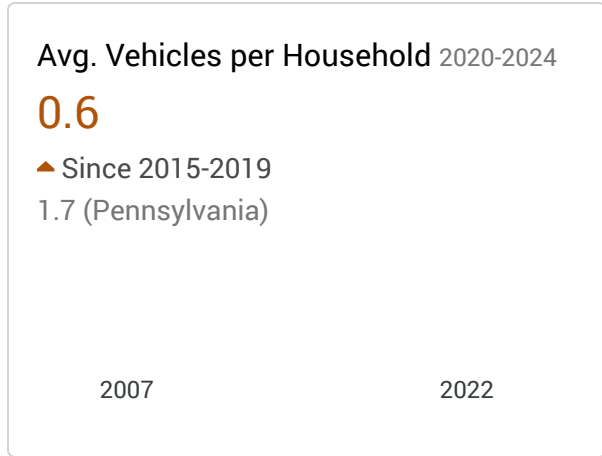

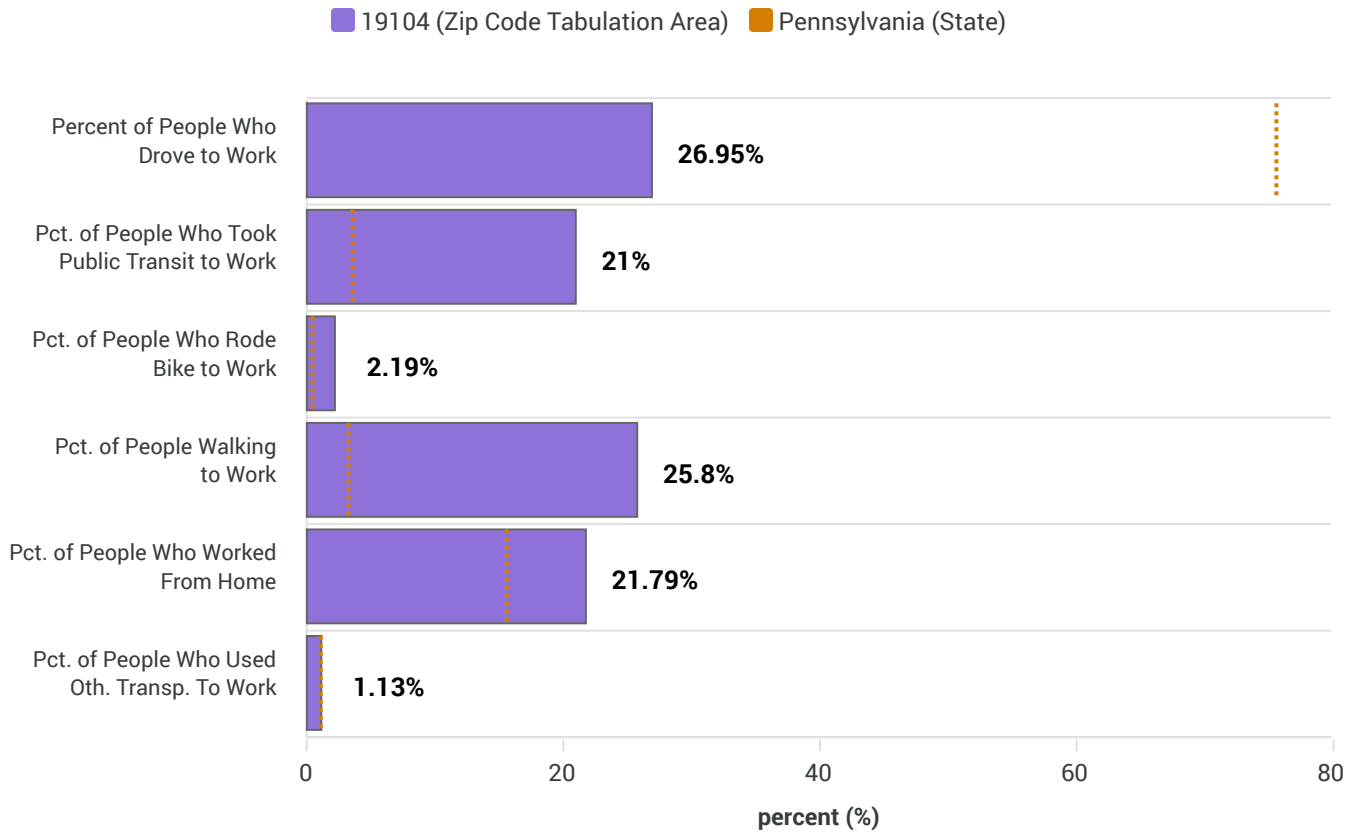
Average Vehicles per Household

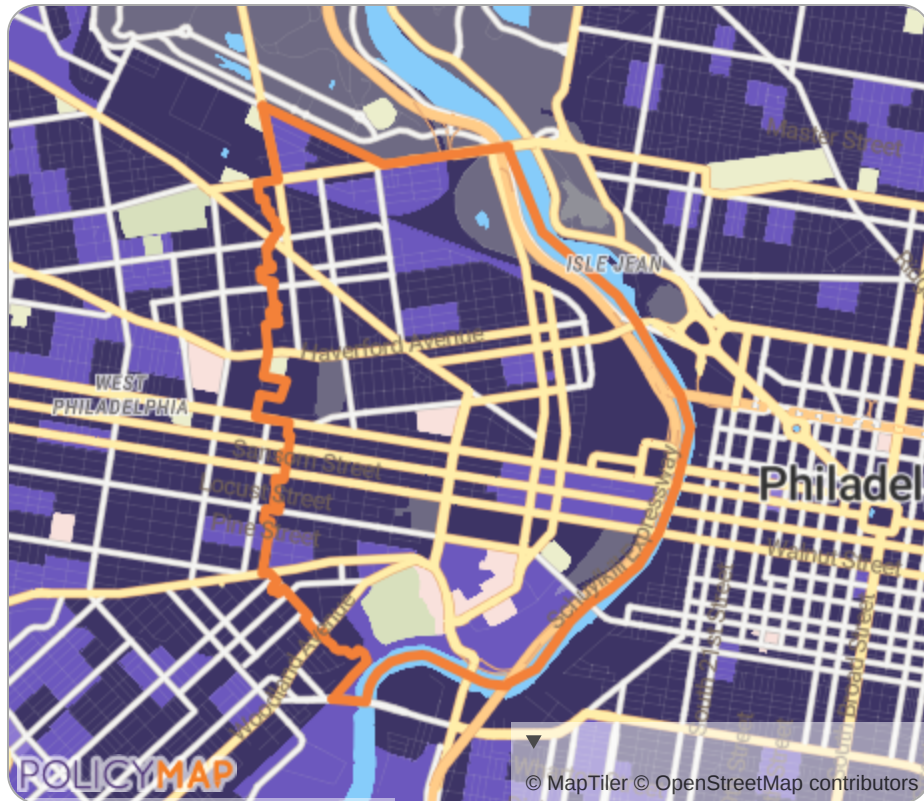
Commute Type 2020-2024

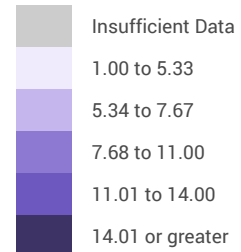

Endnotes

CDC PLACES provides model-based small area estimates of chronic disease and health-related measures derived from the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), Census decennial population counts and annual county population estimates, and the American Community Survey (ACS) 5-year estimates. Prevalence estimates for non-standard geographies, such as custom regions, are calculated by aggregating estimated counts for underlying boundaries and should be considered approximate. Due to the nature of BRFSS survey compilation, PLACES indicators may be unavailable for entire states for certain time periods; see the [Data Dictionary](#) for release-specific notes.
