



















You are now in the **Admin Panel** under the section **Settings**. Here you can adjust how the reservation should be managed. Either **seat-based** or **table-based**.

If your establishment has multiple areas or rooms, you may want to define an area before you start assigning tables to it. e.g.: Indoor, Outdoor, Bar, Lounge, etc. Your active areas are listed below:

Tables are assigned to specific areas. When you pause a whole area, all tables assigned to that area will be paused. This may make some of your future reservations invalid. Don't worry, you can just move them to other available table(s).




