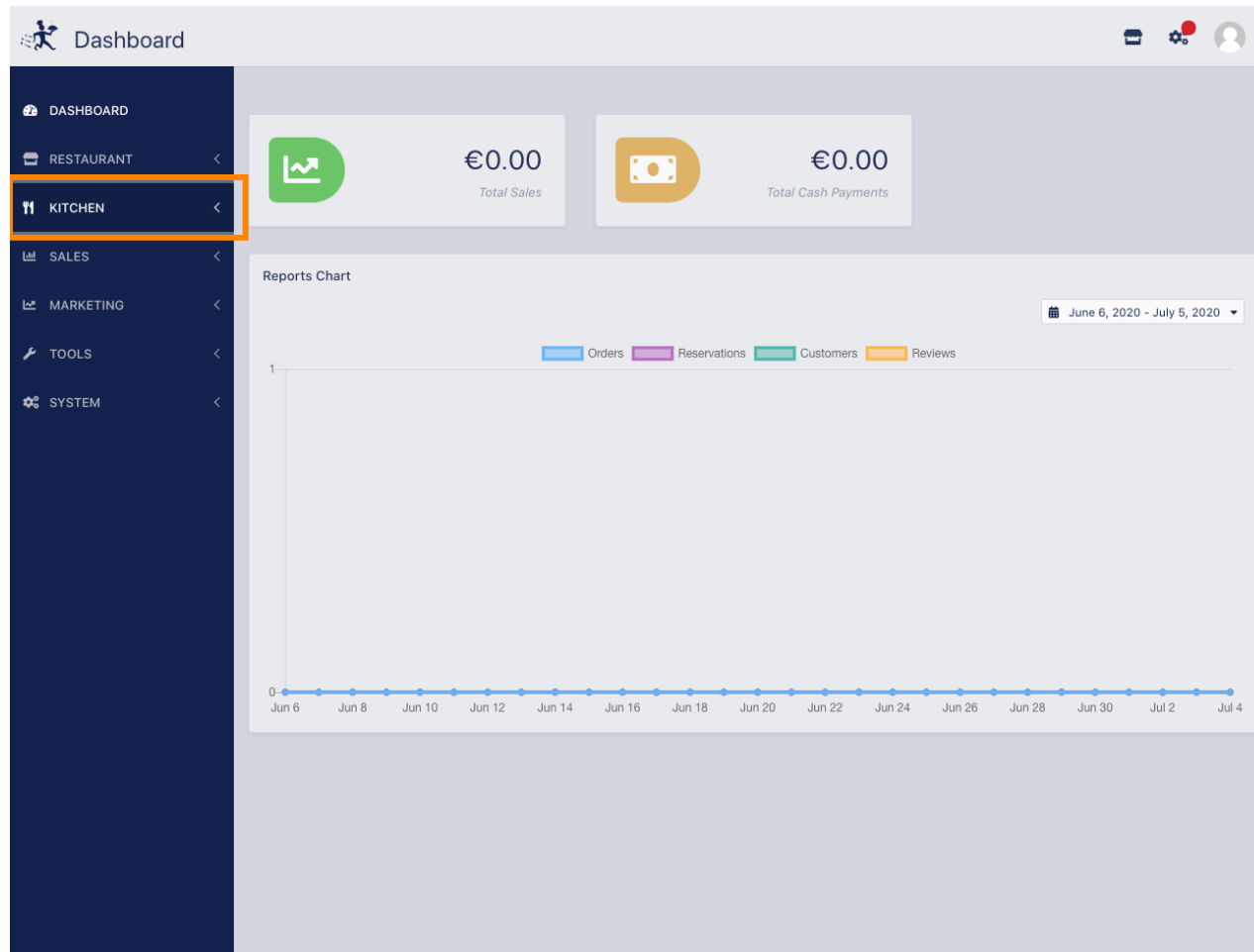
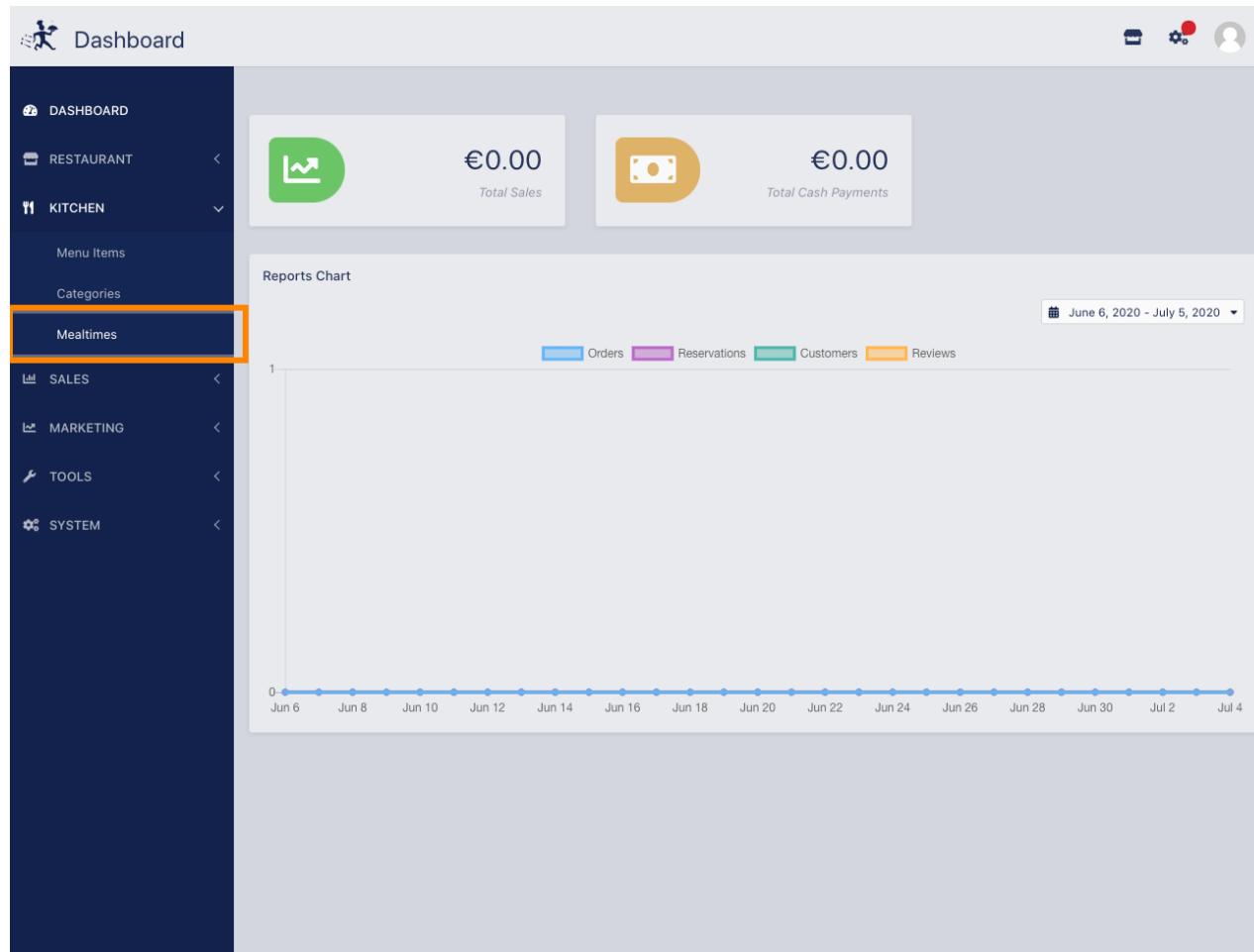


 You are now at the **dashboard**. Click on **kitchen** to start setting up mealtimes.






Click on **mealtimes** to proceed.









Click on **new** to add a new mealtime. **Note: You can edit existing mealtimes by clicking the pencil icon.**


