Count, pronounce, blend, and segment syllables in spoken words.

Segmenting Syllables

Name Chant

Tell students they are going to discover that their names all have a different beat. Help them recognize the number of syllables in their names by repeating this little chant:

Teacher:	Fiddledee doo, fiddledee dee,
	Can you say your name for me?
	My name is (Say your name.)
	(Repeat your name.)
	Let's say my name.
Everyone:	(All repeat your name.)
Teacher:	Now let's clap my name.
	(Say your name while clapping each
	syllable.)
	Do it with me.
Everyone:	(Say your name while clapping each
	syllable.)
Teacher:	(Turn to a student.)
	Fiddledee doo, fiddledee dee,
	Can you say your name for me?
Student:	My name is
Teacher:	(Repeat the student's name.)
reaction.	(Repeat the student's name.)
reaction.	Let's all say your name.

And so on. Begin in unison, selecting the student's name to clap until students get the general idea. Then allow each student to choose the next student, ask her name, repeat the name, and clap the name. For variety, have students replace the clapping with stomping their feet or snapping their fingers.

Magic Carpet

Required Materials:

• Blanket

Tell students that by using their imaginations they can fly anywhere on a magic carpet. Have them sit on a blanket or rug (their magic carpet). Invite each student to think of a place to visit. Give some examples, such as a favorite amusement park, restaurant, or country. Then begin each "trip" with this chant:

Teacher:	Magic Carpet, Magic Carpet,
	Take us away.
	Where shall we go for a very fun day?
	Where do you want to go today,?
	(Choose a student.)
Student:	(Student names a place.)
Teacher:	Let's make a wish.
Everyone:	Magic Carpet, Magic Carpet,
	Take us away.
	We want to go to today. (Repeat the
	place name.)
Teacher:	Get ready. Let's clap
	(Name the chosen place while clapping once for
	each syllable. For example, say "Af-ri-ca" and
	clap three times.)
Students:	· · · · ·
	(Repeat the place name while clapping the
	syllables as before.)
Teacher:	Off we go! (Shake the blanket.)
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
