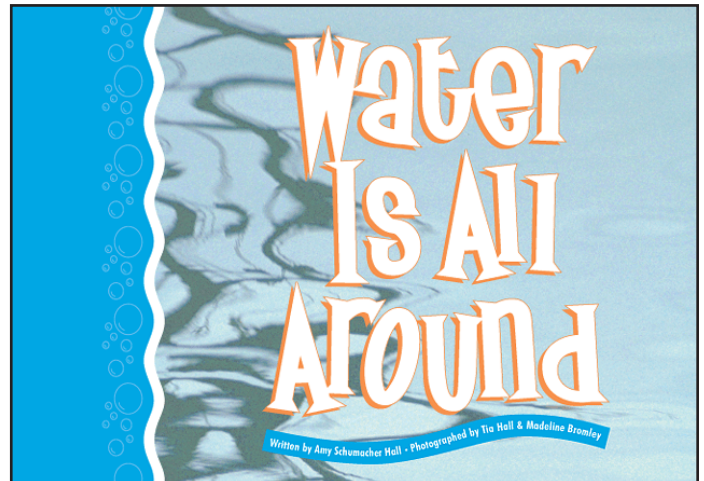

Read the book *Water is All Around*, and use the following question to begin a discussion about the main topic and retell key details of the text.

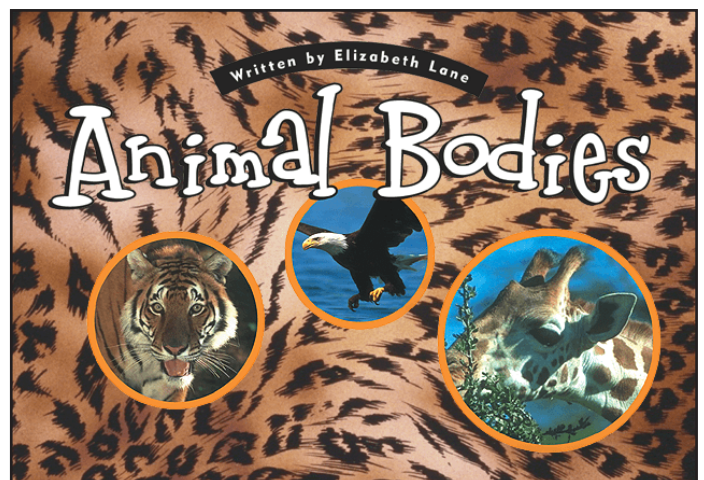
- What is water used for?

Read the book *Animal Bodies*, and use the following question to begin a discussion about the main topic and retell key details of the text.

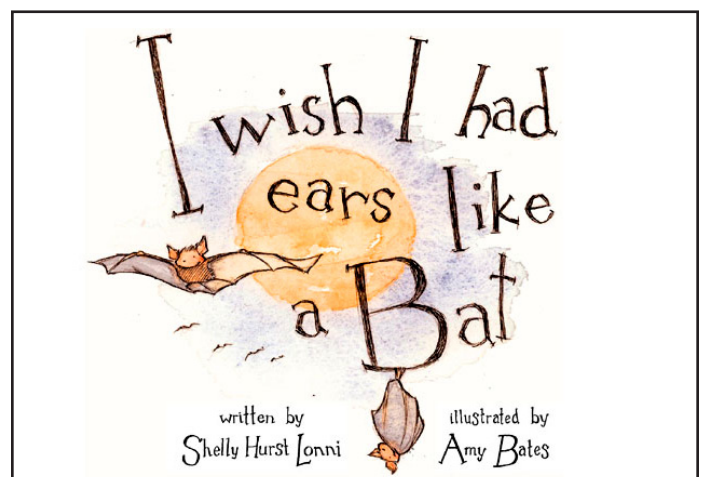
- What are the special things about animals' bodies that help them to survive?

Read the book *I Wish I Had Ears Like a Bat*, and use the following question to begin a discussion about the main topic and retell key details of the text.

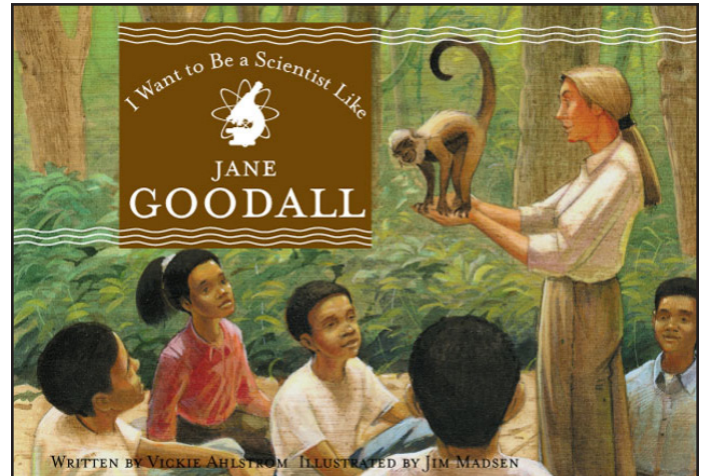
- What special characteristics do different animals have to help them?

Read the book *I Want to Be a Scientist Like Jane Goodall*, and use the following question to begin a discussion about the main topic and retell key details of the text.

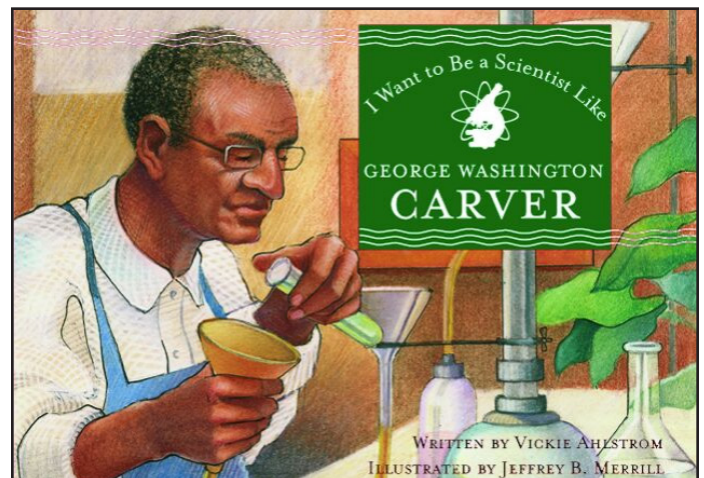
- How did Jane become a scientist?
