## **Tell A Story Activity**

Use the ideas below as a springboard to help students tell a story or recount an experience with appropriate facts and relevant, descriptive details, speaking in complete sentences.

- 1. Have students tell about their favorite pair of shoes or a pair that they would like to make for themselves.
- 2. Have students choose their favorite season and tell about what they like to do during that time.
- 3. Have students tell about their favorite holidays and traditions.
- 4. Have students brainstorm how they use their five senses every day to help them get ready for school.
- 5. Have students choose one of the five senses to tell about. Have them describe what the sense is, how it helps them, and what life might be like without it.
- 6. Have the children think and tell about ways to protect their planet. Possible subjects for this assignment are recycling, planting new trees, composting, and picking up litter.
- 7. Write a class play about the solar system. Divide the class into ten groups and have each group research a planet or the sun and write a brief description. Put each part into a play and have several students act it out.
