

Functionality	Description
<b>Catalog approval: Performance improvements</b>	We have moved the refresh of data to the temp tables behind Catalog approval page for the lower part, from open/filter of form to when the user is changing the records in the upper part. This has improved the performance using the form. In addition we have introduced a popup showing on screen when the data is refreshed to the form, which improve the user experience when filtering in the form with lots of data.
<b>Approve (async)</b>	If there are many products that are approved and also new products that will be created in the approval, then the approve process can be time consuming resulting in "Wait" dialogs for the user to finish the process. Therefore it is now possible to run the approve async with new button 'Approve (async)'.

<b>Import several catalogs with same vendor account</b>	<p>New field 'Reference' on Vendor Catalog to input for example vendor reference, contract ID and similar. If you have several vendor catalogs with same vendor account, then the new reference field can be used to find the correct catalog using import through the web service.</p> <p>When importing a vendor catalog through web service, the value in PJMAVCORGANIZATIONNUMBER in XML-file will be compared with the values in 'Organization number' and 'Reference' fields, where the '#' character is used as divider. Reference must be used if there are more than one active vendor catalog for same vendor account, this to find the correct vendor catalog for uploading the file.</p> <p>For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a file with PJMAVCORGANIZATIONNUMBER = NO980335224MVA will upload the catalog to a vendor catalog with 'Organization number': NO980335224MVA and Reference &lt;blank&gt;.</li> <li>a file with PJMAVCORGANIZATIONNUMBER = NO980335224MVA#123456 will upload the catalog to a vendor catalog with 'Organization number': NO980335224MVA and Reference 123456</li> </ul>

<b>Product name and description is updated on a rejected product when parameters set to No</b>	<p><b>PROBLEM</b></p> <p>Parameters for update of Product name and Product description is set to No, importing product which has previously not been created with Vendor Catalog, Approve rejected product and Release approved product. Product name and Product description is updated on the Released product.</p> <p><b>DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE</b></p> <p>If parameters for update of Product name and Product description is set to No and approve and release of a rejected product, then Product name and Product description is not updated on the Released product. The 'Product status' is also now changed to 'Update' (from previously 'Add') when approving the rejected product.</p>
