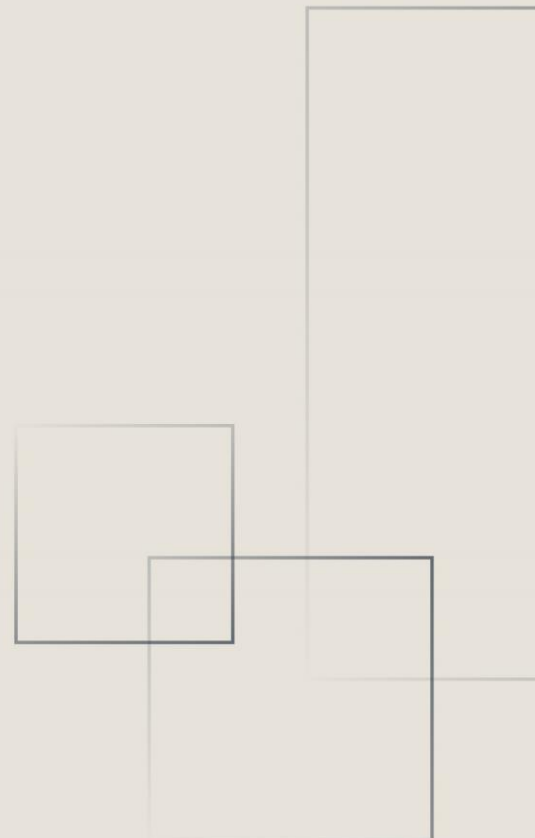

This change minimizes system resource usage during manual updates, enhancing efficiency and user experience.</p>

Improve logging for insertion conflicts	<p>If a unique index is violated, and the record with the same unique index already exist in local company, then the record cannot be pushed. PROBLEM

System is not allowing to let InventModelGroupItem record when creating new released product. Probably it has something in common with the DataAreaField on the configuration of InventModelGroupItem table.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Investigation revealed that root cause of this issue was that the DAT company was added to a company group. Issue is fixed by excluding DAT company from selection for Company groups.

Cannot close form using X button

PROBLEM

Not possible to close the Vendors form as usual if the form is refreshed by the refresh button.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fixed so that the x button closes the form also when the form has been refreshed.

Lookup doesn't work if it's datasource table allows to create local records

PROBLEM

Vendor Bank accounts are not possible to choose from lookup on vendor in local company when Vendor Bank accounts are created in local company for that vendor, and Replication type is set to 'Local' for VendTable. Vendor Bank account can be inserted manually without lookup.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fixed lookup so that record can be selected.

Bugs

Storage Dimension Group not pushed from Default values

PROBLEM

Storage dimension group is blank in local company, even though it's specified in Default values

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Some tables requires default values to be specified with correct RecId instead of the value of the primary key. Validation is added to the Default values form to check if the specified value is valid, and a dropdown with available values are added as well. A Storage dimension group must still be inserted in the released product in global company in order to make the GDM framework detect that there is a record to be synchronized for this table, before the Default value can be selected.

CustInterestVersion - sync and mapping issues

PROBLEM

Synchronization error when synchronizing Cust interest code with several versions.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Issues related to mapping of RefRecId detected and resolved

Reservation hierarchy sync issues

PROBLEM

Error message when trying to synchronize Reservation hierarchy with released product, and default values are not pushed to local company.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Regression error is resolved with bugfix 53965 Cross company tables with the Data Area Field defined synchronizing issue. Default values form is improved through bugfix 54078 Storage Dimension Group not pushed from Default values, but GDM framework still requires that a record is due to be synchronized before default values can be inserted as a replacement for original value.

Deletion of attachments & certificates in GDM

PROBLEM

The deletion of local attachments is performed synchronously immediately after removing it from global company. Depending on amount of companies, it might be a quite intensive work to be done for an environment with a lot of companies configured in GDM.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

The responsibility of removing unnecessary attachments is moved to the GDM batch synchronization task, or through manual synchronization.

New features

Control content of Default Financial Dimensions

A new Replication type called 'Global dimension attributes' is introduced, and is available to use for Data field name 'DefaultDimension' in the Field setup section of the GDM Management form. When this Replication type

is selected, a new setup is made available where each individual Default Financial dimension may be specified to be either copied or not copied from global to local company, together with the parent record, and this configuration may be set up for all companies, or differentiated either per company or Company group.

Bugs

Index name is not automatically populated when using add entity

PROBLEM

When using the 'Add entity' function in GDM Management form, the 'Index name' is not automatically populated. Since this field is mandatory and ineditable after adding a table with the 'Add entity' function, the process is blocked

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

'Index name' is automatically populated when using the 'Add entity' function in GDM Management.

Share supplier 'Print management setup' via GDM

PROBLEM

The 'Batch push data - multithreaded' job is failing when trying to push 'Print management setup' with vendor synchronization, while the 'Improved performance' parameter is enabled.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fixed so that the Print management setup might be synchronized together with vendors also through 'Batch push data - multithreaded' the without error, also while the 'Improved performance' parameter is enabled.

GDM default values - Site and Warehouse

PROBLEM

When Default values are specified for 'InventDimIdDefault' on either 'InventItemPurchSetup', 'InventItemInventSetup' or 'InventItemSalesSetup', only Site gets the Default value on the item in local company

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fixed so that both Site and Warehouse from Default values are applied on items in local company.

Nothing recreated in 'Record updates' when Selection criteria is activated in a cross company table where 'Data area field' is set up

PROBLEM

When table is cross company, and but has "Data area field" set up in the GDM Management form, then no records will be re-created in "Record updates" on criteria activation

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Recreation issue is resolved also for cross company tables where 'Data area field' is set up

Deactivated records are still synchronized

PROBLEM

When a record with Update type = Delete in Record update is removed and get the 'Not in use' flag enabled, it is still processed by the synchronization jobs. The result can then be that synchronization is blocked due to cancelled records in Record updates, which are not allowed to be deleted in local company

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Record updates where Not in use = true is no longer processed by the synchronization jobs.

When activating new criteria for table, no "company update" records will be created

PROBLEM

When a 'Selection criteria' is enabled for a table which is set up in GDM Management, the code which determines the records to be created in Record updates doesn't consider the table relation. Therefore, if a record with the same RecId, but in a different table, already exist in Record updates, it will not be created.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Code is fixed to also consider table relation when activating a 'Selection criteria'

Deleting document attachments fails on GDM-enabled table

PROBLEM

When attempting to remove an attachment from a record in a GDM enabled table which is set up to synchronize documents, an error occurs and the attachment is not possible to remove.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Code is fixed and it is now possible to remove the attachment from the record in global company if needed.

Allow create local records parameter enables edit in local company for global records

PROBLEM

If 'Allow create' is set to 'Allow create local records', then in local company it is possible to create a new record as well as modify any field of the records that previously were created and synchronized from the master data company.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

When 'Allow create' is set to 'Allow create local records', then the records which were created in local company may be modified, while the records created and pushed from the master data company can only be modified if the 'Replication type' for that particular field is set to 'Local'.

Improvements

Add contacts

When the 'Allow create' parameter is set to either 'None' or 'Allow create global from local' on table ContactPerson, then the 'Add contacts' button is now disabled in the Contacts dropdown on the ribbon of vendor and customer forms in local companies.

Automatic retries on batch jobs

CHALLENGE

In version 10.0.18 of D365, batch job framework introduces support for retrievable tasks. To support that, a minor change to "Push data" task must be implemented.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Both standard and multi-threaded "push data" jobs were implemented to support the possibility of automatically retry. Additionally, standard "Push data" job were migrated from classic "RunBaseBatch" pattern to "SysOperation" pattern.

Records in related tables are not deleted

PROBLEM

If customer had DXC GDM 10.14.38.3 installed and SQL triggers were updated after installation, when removing records from master company, local records were not removed.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Code responsible for creating SQL triggers for GDM-controlled tables is fixed.

Reset query in Selection management

PROBLEM

When clicking the 'Reset' button in the query form in 'Selection management', then a wrong table is shown. The form has to be closed and reopened again for the reset of the query is in place

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fixed issue so that the original query is applied in the form when clicking the 'Reset' button

GDM setup of VendCategory table

PROBLEM

When adding new table configuration on GDM Management form, error message was displayed. Furthermore, new categories added to a vendor is not logged as 'New' in the 'Push data' form.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Error when adding the VendCategory table to the GDM setup is fixed, and when categories are added to a vendor they are now logged as 'New' in the 'Push data' form.

BUGFIXES

Refresh entity cause error by GDM

PROBLEM

Users cannot fully use the 'Refresh entity list' functionality. Each time they try to run it in non-Production environments (after the earlier database refresh), they receive the error message 'Cannot create a record in Target XML (DMFTargetXML). Entity: Definition Groups, DESCRIPTION. The record already exists.'

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Issue fixed so that the 'Refresh entity list' can run without error

Manual pull does not pull records

PROBLEM

When parameter 'Improved performance' is enabled, the manual pull doesn't always work

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

When 'Improved performance' is enabled, the local company record wasn't considered. Added condition to consider local company and select correct criteria when running synchronization or manual push or pull, when 'Improved performance' is enabled.

IMPROVEMENTS

Improved mapping of record updates to existing Foreign record ID

When a record in a table is connected to a related table by the RecId, and the related record already exists in the local company, then this record needs to be mapped to the related record in the local company even though the Foreign record ID is not identified by GDM at this point. GDM synchronization will now be able to identify the Foreign Rec ID if it exists in the local company, or create a new record if it doesn't, based on the related record's RecID in the local company.

Keep batch job running

A new parameter 'Keep batch job running' is added to the GDM parameters. When enabled, then the 'Batch push data' jobs will continue processing the waiting record updates for the current company, even if a critical error occurs on one record during synchronization.

Jumpref and data title fields in Record updates

Standard data title fields for D365FO records are now implemented in the 'Record updates' form, for better information and identification of records. In addition, it is now possible to navigate directly to the specific record by clicking the link on the 'Global record ID'.

Clean tables for reference when deleting legal entity

If a legal entity is deleted, then the company is automatically removed from the GDM Company groups, and references in GDM tables are now cleaned up as well as part of the process.

NOTE: It is necessary to run the 'Update triggers' job from the Global data management/Periodic menu after installation of new GDM version, in order to let the changes take effect.

NEW FEATURES

GDM workspace for monitoring and follow-up

The new GDM workspace provides various KPI's and lists of synchronization issues and error logs for easier follow-up and correction of issues. Logging of synchronization issues is enabled by the 'Logging enabled' parameter in GDM parameters.

Limit maximum number for threads for the 'Batch push data - multi-threaded' job

A new GDM parameter 'Maximum batch threads' has been added to limit how many threads the 'Batch push data - multi-threaded' job can utilize, in order to ensure that there are available threads left for other batch jobs to be processed simultaneously. If the parameter is left blank, then all available threads will be utilized as before.

GDM Performance improvement

Caching level reset back to 'NotInTTS' from 'EntireTable' for TGDCCompanyUpdate table. Additionally, minor adjustments are done to the 'Clean up company updates' job.

Reduce how often the Creation of the Record updates job is executed in Selection management

The asynchronous job 'Creation of the Record updates' were initiated whenever a record change was saved in the Selection management form. The result was that the job might be executed several times during maintenance of the setup, and this could be confusing to the user. This behavior has now been improved to ensure that the job is only executed when the changes made require an update of the Record updates to be aligned with the current setup.

NEW FEATURES

Batch job to identify and delete duplicate records in recordupdate table

DESCRIPTION

When a table has extensive amount of data which need to be synchronized through GDM, and there already exist a significant number of duplicate records in the 'Record updates' table, then the batch job will have to run for a very long time to process all records. Also, to remove and replace the 'Record updates' by deactivating and activating the setup in 'Selection management' would be a time consuming task.

A new batch job 'Clean up Record updates' is added, which effectively will identify and delete duplicate records in the 'Record updates' table in a less time-consuming way.

Issue vendor primary contact

DESCRIPTION

First synchronization of a vendor with Primary contact assigned fails due to standard validations, since the Contact person which is assigned to the vendor doesn't exist in local company yet. The contact person would have to be synchronized first, or the vendor would have to be synchronized to local company before Primary contact is specified and updated in next synchronization. If not, the validation of the Vendor table would have to be skipped in order to insert the Primary contact to the vendor in the local company.

The 'Preinitialize related record' field has been added to the 'Relation' tab of the Management form. This parameter may be enabled on a record to ensure that for that particular field, the related record is initialized in the local company before the record is initialized on the main table, and the validation is skipped. This allows the main record to be pushed, including the required related field, without any error.

BUGFIXES

Change in Item group on a released product is not pushed automatically to local companies

PROBLEM

Item group is changed on a released product, but the change is not pushed local companies. The reason is that the InventItemGroupItem table is a Cross-company table, and triggers are not enabled for Cross-company tables in GDM.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

A new field 'Data area field' is added to the Table setup in the Management form. This field overrides the default 'DataAreaID' field for the tables when constructing the database triggers. Furthermore, if defined it will force to create triggers even for Cross-company tables. The field is only available for Cross-company tables. For other tables where nothing is specified in this field, then the table will be using the 'DataAreaID' field as before.

Note: After this field is changed, the 'Update triggers' job is required to be run in order to apply the changes.

Issues with batch

PROBLEM

Customers experienced, that synchronization of data between master and child companies could sometime take multiple hours.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

To optimize the process of synchronization, code was analyzed to detect places where optimization is possible and we have limited number of database lookups during the process. The observed improvement was ~20% on our test data-set. To be sure to not degrade performance on different data sets, the "Improved performance" switch was introduced on GDM parameters form. This parameter must be enabled in order to benefit from this optimization.

Error in GDM Batch push data - multi-threaded

PROBLEM

Not possible to run the periodic job Batch push data - multi-threaded from the Global data management periodic menu due to an error message.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fix is implemented and the Batch push data - multi-threaded can now be run as expected without error. Additional fix also implemented to handle batch execution mode, not only client execution.

IMPROVEMENTS

Record updates duplicates are created when changing "Selection criteria"

IMPROVEMENT

General performance improvement as result of eliminating creation of duplicates when changes are made to a setup in Selection management

Timeout when Edit query

IMPROVEMENT

Optimized mechanism to insert 'Record updates' when activating a setup in Selection management, to increase performance

PROBLEM

When changes are made to a record in 'Selection management', the solution locks the session while it automatically regenerates the 'Record updates' for the table. When a table holds a lot of data, and the query used results in a large number of records, this may cause the session to timeout.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

A new parameter 'Recreate the Record updates asynchronously' is added in order to provide the option to run the recreation of the Record updates asynchronously through a temporary batch job. Then the user can continue working in the user session while the job is running in the background, though the actual 'Selection management' record is not possible to change until the job has finished.

Error in GDM Batch push data - multi-threaded

PROBLEM

Not possible to run the periodic job Batch push data - multi-threaded from the Global data management periodic menu due to an error message.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fix is implemented and the Batch push data - multi-threaded can now be run as expected without error.

Issues pushing data to multiple companies

PROBLEM

Creation and update of records in target companies trigger new records in 'Record updates' (TGDCCompanyUpdate table), which generates a lot of redundant data.

The 'Update' trigger logic was modified to only create records from global company in 'Record updates'.

OPTIONAL ACTIONS

Triggers are not updated automatically. To update them, go to "Global data management/Periodic/Update triggers" task and run it when suitable.

Filter on company

PROBLEM

When activating Selection management settings for a table where entries already exist in 'Record updates' table for companies included in the settings, then an error message is thrown: 'Cannot filter on since it's not a valid company'

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fetch mode for a query to select records which needs to have 'Record updates' created is fixed. Furthermore, the query now uses 'addLink' instead of obsolete 'Relation on a range' style

Shelf live issues on 10.0.16

PROBLEM

Push of new batch controlled item to local company fails when 'Shelf advice period in days' or 'Shelf life period in days' is inserted prior to first push. This is due to changes in standard validation of the record in related tables in version 10.0.16

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Changed the initialization of the InventTable record to pre-initialize some of the related tables, to ensure that the related data exist and record can be validated before insert of new released product.

PROBLEM

Fields set up to be maintained globally (Replication type = Global) in GDM Management, but some fields (ie. Delivery terms and Delivery mode) are still editable on the customer in local company.

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE

Fix is implemented on Customer form to ensure that GDM settings will be applied for all ordinary fields.

Update field setup in GDM management

KNOWN ISSUE

Rework of relations in synchronization process result in faulty identifiers in the field setup in GDM Management.

SOLUTION

New choice added to the "Refresh field setup" in the Management form, with the possibility to refresh field setup for all tables in GDM management.

This will fix faulty identifiers in the field setup.

Global data management has been corrected, TableRecId was missing in the scripts for updates all record. This means that for example an update to a specific record in e.g. table CustGroup could mark a record, with identic RecId, in e.g. table VendGroup for update. This has been corrected, in order to only update a specific record TableRecId has been added to the script.

Note! After implementing this change in an environment the Global Data Management task "Update triggers" must be run.
