



- ⓘ Click the pencil icon to edit POS Devices.








ⓘ Click on the arrow to select a Ticket printer.



- ⓘ Click on **None** to select a Connected Pin. Note: it is possible that you have no Connected Pin.




- ⓘ In our case we have no Connected Pin, so we select **None**.






