



Booq - How do I modify the QR Payment messages?

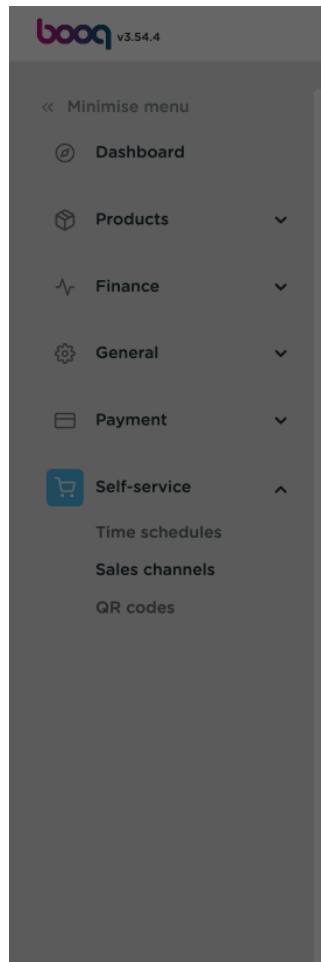


Then select **Content** from the menu on the right.





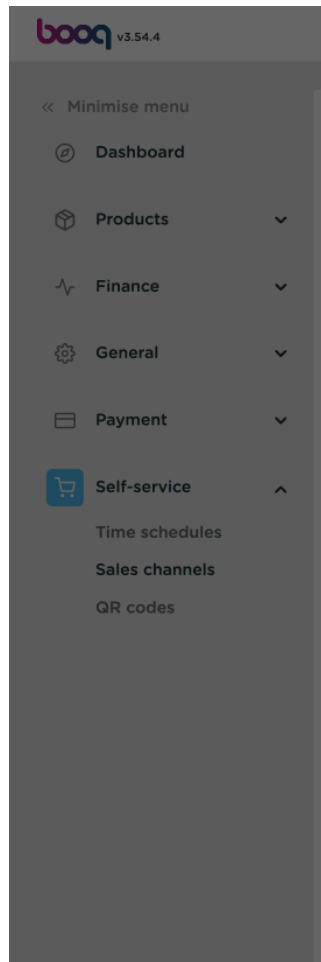
