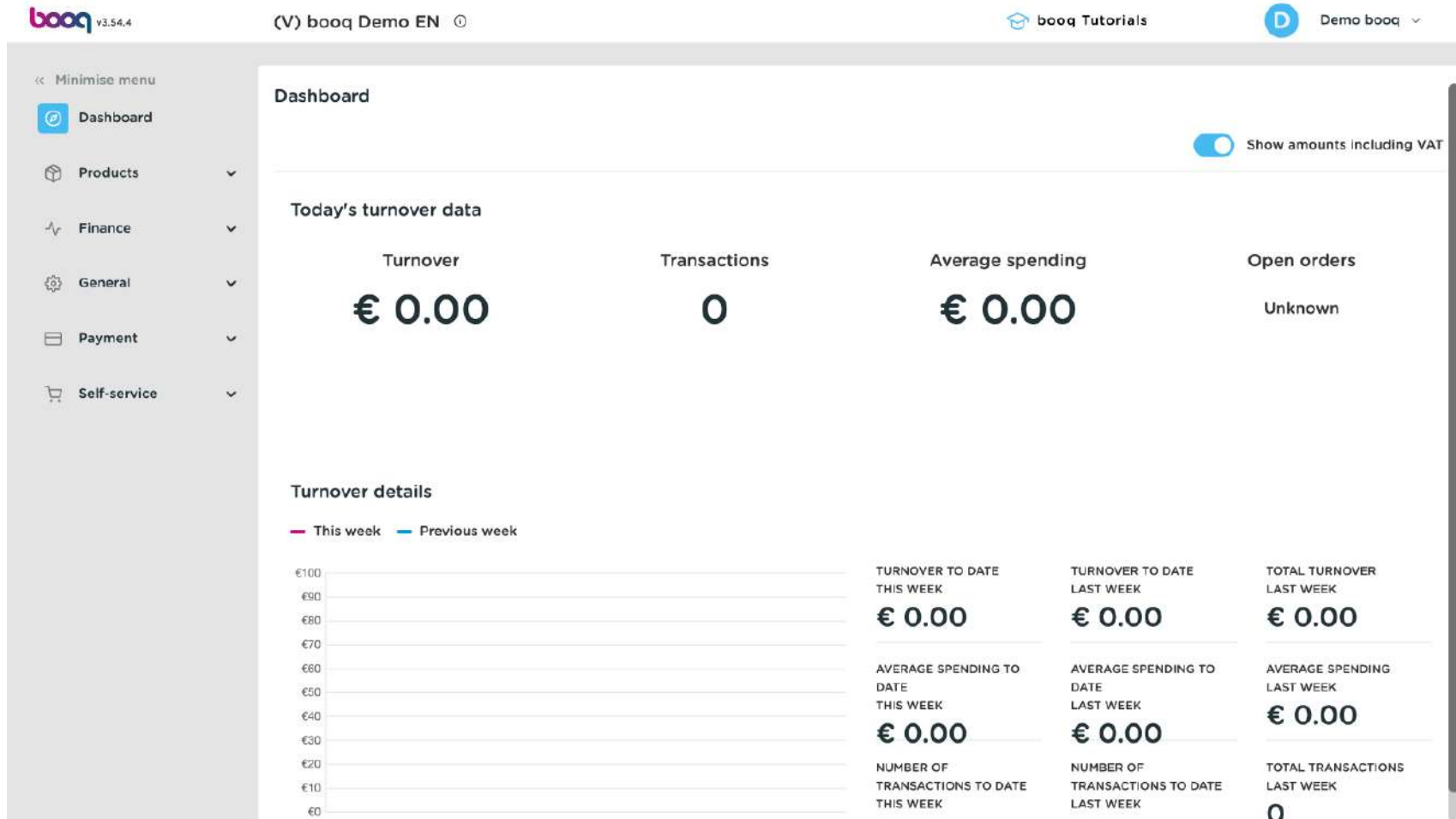




How do I link 2 menus to one ordering kiosk sales channel?
